APPROVED LATE ITEMS:

ATTORNEY GENERAL- DEPT. OF JUSTICE

A1. Authorized with Councilor Wheeler voting **no**, the department to accept and expend funds in the amount of \$6,504,769 from the National Mortgage Settlement for the purposes of providing direct and indirect assistance to distressed homeowners and for increased law enforcement resources within DOJ related to the investigation and prosecution of financial fraud effective with the approval of the Fiscal Committee and the Governor and Council through June 30, 2013. **100% Other Funds (Mortgage Settlement Funds). Contingent upon Fiscal Committee approval on October 26, 2012**

ATTORNEY GENERAL- DEPT. OF JUSTICE

A2. Authorized the department to enter into contracts with the following for the purpose of providing greater access to legal services for homeowners facing foreclosures: New Hampshire Legal Assistance, Concord in the amount of \$1,558,084; Legal Advice Referral Center, Concord, in the amount of \$1,172,407; and New Hampshire Bar Assoc. Legal Services, Concord, in the amount of \$769,509. Effective the date of G&C approval for a 12-month period, with an option for two subsequent annual renewals, subject to G&C approval, through Sept. 18, 2015. **100% Agency Income (Mortgage Settlement Funds)**

ATTORNEY GENERAL- DEPT. OF JUSTICE

A3. Authorized the department to enter into Memorandum of Agreement with the New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority, Manchester, in the amount of \$2,500,000 which will be issued in the form of grants to HUD certified counseling agencies within the state to provide services related to foreclosure prevention, credit and debt counseling, and post-foreclosure issues effective the date of G&C approval through September 14, 2015. **100% Agency Income (Mortgage Settlement Funds)**

DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

B. Authorized the department, Division of Forest and Lands to accept and expend \$2,260,000 of a grant award of \$2,752,000 from the Northeastern Areas State and Private Forestry for the Department’s acquisition of a 1,260 +/- acre Conservation Easement in the Towns of Greenfield, Bennington, and Frankestown in Hillsborough County, known as the “Crotched Mountain Forest Legacy Project” upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2013. **100% Federal Funds.**

DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

C1. Request of the department, pursuant to RSA 21-I:8 II(a), for an extension of time for the Bureau of Financial Reporting to complete the Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for the State fiscal year 2012, from September 28, 2012 to October 28, 2012.

DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

C2. Authorized the Bureau of Public Works Design and Construction to enter into a contract with DL King, Nashua, for a total price not to exceed \$927,700 for the NHARNG Administration Building Renovations, Center Strafford. Effective upon Governor and Council approval through July 12, 2013, unless extended in accordance with contract terms. **100% Federal Funds.** 2) Further authorized the amount of \$45,000 to be approved for payment to the Bureau of Public Works Design and Construction for engineering services provided, bringing the total to \$972,700 **100% Federal Funds.**
