APPROVED ITEMS #’s 1-16, 18, 20-36, 38-166

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ITEM REMOVED FROM TABLE

The Governor and Council on motion of Councilor St. Hilaire, seconded by Councilor Sununu, voted to remove item #29- which was tabled at the October 17, 2012 Meeting.

ATTORNEY GENERAL – DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

#29 **DENIED** – The Governor and Council on motion of Councilor St. Hilaire, seconded by Councilor Sununu, voted to **deny** the petition of Joshua D. Brunet (age 27) requesting a pardon hearing for the offenses of Habitual Offender and Operating After Suspension. The petitioner is not eligible for an annulment.

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ITEM REMOVED FROM TABLE

The Governor and Council on motion of Councilor St. Hilaire, seconded by Councilor Sununu, voted to remove item #30- which was tabled at the October 17, 2012 Meeting.

ATTORNEY GENERAL – DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

#30 **DENIED** – The Governor and Council on motion of Councilor St. Hilaire, seconded by Councilor Sununu, voted to **deny** the petition of Darryl Bickham (age 51) requesting a pardon hearing for the offense of Aggravated Felonious Sexual Assault. The petitioner is not eligible for an annulment.

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LATE ITEM – TABLED

DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

A2. **TABLED** – The Governor and Council on motion of Councilor Wheeler, seconded by Councilor Sununu, and with Councilor St. Hilaire voting **no, tabled** the request of the Bureau of Public Works Design and Construction to enter into a **sole source** contract with Greene & Russell, Inc., Concord, for a total price not to exceed \$223,225, for the Regional Training Institute and Barracks Facility in Pembroke. Effective upon G&C approval through June 30, 2013, unless extended in accordance with the contract terms. **100% Federal Funds.**

DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES

A1. Authorized to accept and place on file the report and findings of Councilor Raymond Wieczorek with regard to the financing of certain improvements as well as refinancing of certain existing indebtedness in connection with Catholic Medical Center, Manchester.

DEPARTMENT OF RESOURCES AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

B. Authorized to amend grant funds from grant #SBAHQ-11-IT-0038 in the amount of \$33,490 between classes for the best use of available funds awarded by the US Small Business Administration-State Trade and Export Promotion (STEP) Grant and **retroactively** extend the grant end date from Sept. 29, 2012 to June 30, 2013. **100% Federal Funds. Approved by Fiscal Committee Nov. 8, 2012.**

DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE ADMINISTRATION

C. Authorized to enter into a contract with Robert Half International, Manchester, for temporary data entry services in an amount not to exceed \$117,000 to commence upon the date of G&C approval and extend up to 20 consecutive weeks, beginning on or about Nov. 15, 2012 to April 11, 2013. **100% General Funds.**
