These supplemental sub grants will allow the sub grantees to continue their educational and enforcement-related activities in their communities and in their regions.

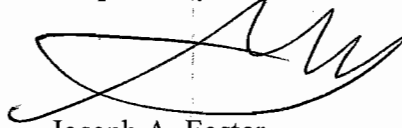
