**REQUESTED ACTION**

1. Authorize the Department of Transportation to enter into a contract with M.E. Latulippe Construction, Inc. (Vendor 157609) of Ashland, NH on the basis of a low bid of \$241,900.00 for the removal of the bridge that formerly carried NH Route 25 over Baker River and modifications of the existing bridge abutments to accommodate a future bridge by others, from the date of Governor and Council approval through July 29, 2016 unless extended by the Department in accordance with the Standard Specifications. 100% Federal Funds.

2. Further authorize that a contingency in the amount of \$12,095.00 be approved for payment of latent conditions, which may appear during the construction of the project. The contingency requested is 5% of the contract amount.

**EXPLANATION**

This project was initiated at the request of the Town and addresses the safety concerns associated with the very poor condition of the truss bridge, which is potentially unstable. The existing bridge is an historic steel high-truss with a span of approximately 97 feet. The bridge was bypassed in 1937 when NH Route 25 was relocated and reconstructed, with a new bridge, about 600 feet to the west and downstream of the old bridge. This bridge is not on the Red List as it has been closed/barricaded since 1987, and thus does not carry any vehicular traffic. Use by pedestrians was allowed until November 2013 when it was completely closed. The in-depth inspection and load rating analysis completed in

2014 indicates that the bridge can no longer safely support all anticipated loads. Due to the public safety concerns created by this situation, the Department proposes to remove this bridge and modify the abutments to accept a covered bridge by others to restore the pedestrian crossing. Upon completion of the project, the ownership of the bridge and adjacent roadways will be turned over to the Town of Wentworth. The Department marketed the bridge for re-use in compliance with 23 USC Section 144. Marketing occurred for a period of at least 14 days and included advertising on the Department's website. There were no offers or proposals for use of the Wentworth Village Road Bridge.


The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. This contingency is warranted to account for latent conditions during the modifications of the existing abutments. It is possible that additional modifications may be required once the abutments are exposed and additional removal and reconstruction than shown on the plans is necessary.

The Contractor has been prequalified by this Department. The Contract has been approved by the Attorney General as to form and execution, and the Department has certified that the necessary funds are available and that the bid reasonably conforms to the engineer's estimate in accordance with State procedure. Copies of the fully executed contract are on file at the Secretary of State's Office and the Department of Administrative Service's Office, and subsequent to Governor and Council approval will be on file at the Department of Transportation.

This project funding is 80% federal funds with 20% state match. Turnpike toll credit is being utilized for match requirements, effectively using 100% federal funds.

A copy of the Tabulation of Bids received for this project is attached along with the Contract Supplemental Sheet and a map indicating the location of the project.

## SUPPLEMENTAL PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

**DESCRIPTION:** This project consists of the removal of the bridge that formerly carried NH Route 25 over Baker River and modifications of the existing bridge abutments to accommodate a future bridge by others. The existing bridge is an historic steel high-truss with a span of approximately 97 feet. The bridge was bypassed in 1937 when NH Route 25 was relocated and reconstructed, with a new bridge, about 600 feet to the west and downstream of the old bridge.

**FEDERAL FUNDING:** 80% with anticipated utilization of Turnpike Toll Credits for the State's 20% match.

**CONTINGENCY:** The proposed contingency amount is 5% of the contract amount. This contingency is warranted due to the modifications of the existing abutments. It is possible that additional modifications may be required once the abutments are exposed to remove and replace more than is shown on the plans.


**PROJECT INITIATED:** This project was initiated to address the safety concerns associated with the bridge, which can no longer support all anticipated loads.

**PROJECT EXPLANATION:** This bridge is not on the Red List as it has been closed/barricaded since 1987, and thus does not carry any vehicular traffic. Use by pedestrians was allowed until November 2013 when it was completely closed. The in-depth inspection and load rating analysis completed in 2014 indicates that the bridge can no longer safely support all anticipated loads. Due to the public safety concerns created by this situation, the Department proposes to remove this bridge and modify the abutments to accept a covered bridge by others to restore the pedestrian crossing. Upon completion of the project, it is proposed to turn over ownership of the bridge and adjacent roadways to the Town of Wentworth. NHDOT marketed the bridge for re-use in compliance with 23 USC Section 144. Marketing occurred for a period of at least 14 days and included advertising on the NHDOT website. There were no offers or proposals for use of the Wentworth Village Road Bridge.

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**TRAFFIC IMPLICATION:** No traffic implications are anticipated since bridge is currently closed to both vehicular and pedestrian traffic.
