

**EXPLANATION**

NH Police Standards and Training, through a previous grant award, received and installed a VirTra 300 use of force simulator, which is used to train NH law enforcement officers in responding to incidents involving force instituted by domestic or foreign terrorism. The purpose of this grant award is to replace the current vendor unsupported VirTra 300 simulator with an upgraded supported VirTra 300 system. This will allow Police Standards & Training to continue to provide interactive scenario based training to law enforcement and corrections officers throughout the State in responding to terrorist and active shooter situations.

General Funds or Highway Funds will not be used should Federal Funds become unavailable.
