Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Dan A. Jimenez to Position #9U540 (Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-26100000-013-500132) as an Attorney at a salary level of \$78,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or November 30, 2020, whichever is later.

EXPLANATION

Mr. Jimenez graduated from Guilford College in 2009 with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science (concentration in Economics). While studying there, he played rugby and was elected to the Student Senate. He earned his Juris Doctor in May 2012 from Suffolk University Law School, where he was an officer in the Student Bar Association and member of the Latin American Law Student Association. Mr. Jimenez tried more than 40 jury trials and more than 50 bench trials as an Assistant District Attorney at the Plymouth County District Attorney's Office in Brockton, Massachusetts, between January 2013 and February 2019. In addition to his own caseload, he supervised other attorneys prosecuting in the Brockton, Wareham, and Plymouth District Courts. He was a founding member of the District Attorney's Diversity and Inclusion Internal Committee. Mr. Jimenez has been an Assistant Attorney General in the White Collar and Public Integrity Division of the Massachusetts Attorney General's Office since February 2019. He was admitted to the Massachusetts Bar in 2012 and is pending admission to the New Hampshire Bar under NH Supreme Court Rule 42, XI(a). In light of Mr. Jimenez's experience, I am requesting he be appointed as an Attorney at a salary of \$78,000. He will be assigned to the Criminal Bureau, Public Integrity Unit. 
