REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources, Division of Historical Resources to Budget and Expend \$33,027 of balance forward revenue and Accept and Expend \$4,240 of new revenue for a total of \$37,267, to support New Hampshire's Enhanced Mapping and Management Information Tool (EMMIT), effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval through June 30, 2021. 100% Other Funds (Agency Income).

EXPLANATION

The Division of Historical Resources (DHR) is requesting \$37,267 in new and carry forward funds from the Enhanced Mapping and Management Information Tool (EMMIT) account be appropriated for FY 2021.

New Hampshire's EMMIT is a publicly accessible Geographic Information System administered by the DHR. This system gives subscribers a convenient means of accessing records pertaining to the state's historic and archaeological resources. Subscribers have the ability to perform searches based on locational parameters as well as user-specified attribute criteria. The purpose of this system is to provide these materials to its subscribers in an efficient way, while maintaining a comprehensive archive of the statewide survey of historic properties in an ongoing initiative. The information contained in EMMIT represents the State's sole comprehensive, up-to-date inventory of the State's historic and archaeological resources.

DIIR requires an annual maintenance contract with a vendor in order to cover the costs for hosting, updating, and maintaining the EMMIT system and tools. The DIIR created EMMIT as a user-subscription service in order to cover these costs. These costs are not covered by any other funding source.
