REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to reappoint Christina M. Wilson (Position 9U605, Appropriation #02-20-20-201010-2623-013-500132) as an Assistant Attorney General at a salary of \$71,000 effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or April 1, 2021, whichever is later, for a term ending April 1, 2026.

EXPLANATION

Ms. Wilson is a resident of Concord and a member of the New Hampshire Bar. She earned her undergraduate degree from Quinnipiac University in 2012 and her law degree from the University of New Hampshire School of Law in 2016. Following law school, she served as a Superior Court law clerk from 2016 to 2018. She joined the New Hampshire Department of Justice as an Attorney in 2018 and was appointed an Assistant Attorney General in 2019. Ms. Wilson is assigned to the Transportation and Construction Bureau. I plan to continue her current salary and assignment. A copy of her resume is attached.

RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.


