The Department of Transportation requests placement of this item on the Consent Calendar.

Pursuant to RSA 230:14, revise the Commission for the hearing on the proposed reconstruction of the intersection of NH Route 108, Amesbury Road and Maple Avenue in Newton.

On April 7, 2021, item number 4E, the Governor and Executive Council authorized the Bureau of Right-of-Way's petition for a hearing, and the appointment of a Commission of Three Persons. The membership of the suggested committee has since changed to include Councilor Janet L. Stevens, in place of Christopher Cross at the Councilor's request.


I, Victoria F. Sheehan, Commissioner of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, in accordance with RSA 230:14, propose the reconstruction of NH Rte. 108, Amesbury Road and Maple Avenue, also known as "Rowe's Corner," at the location described below.

Newton – 29617 X-A004(206)

This project will reconstruct the intersection of NH Route 108, Amesbury Road and Maple Avenue, as well as alter the approaches of NH Route 108, reconfiguring the intersection to a traditional four-way stop design. The proposed work will extend approximately 300 feet north and west along NH Route 108, approximately 300 feet south along Amesbury Road and approximately 200 feet east along Maple Avenue.

This project may impact historic properties.

Therefore, I, Victoria F. Sheehan, Commissioner of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, in accordance with RSA 230:14, propose the reconstruction of the intersection of NH Rte. 108, Amesbury Road and Maple Avenue, also known as "Rowe's Corner."
