REQUESTED ACTION

1. Pursuant to RSA 4:39-c and RSA 228:31, authorize the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (Department) to sell a 3.56 +/- acre parcel of state-owned land with improvements, located on the northerly side of U.S. Route 2 in the Town of Shelburne. The sale will be to William F. Misk (Grantee) for \$95,000.00 plus an \$1,100.00 administrative fee, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval.

2. The Department further requests authorization to compensate Badger Realty from the proceeds of the subject sale in the amount of \$5,700.00 (6%) for real estate services, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval.

The Department's Bureau of Finance and Contracts determined the subject property was purchased with 80% Federal Funds and 20% Highway Funds.

EXPLANATION

The Department wishes to dispose of a 3.56 +/- acre parcel of state-owned land with improvements, located on U.S. Route 2 in the Town of Shelburne. The subject parcel is a portion of a larger parcel acquired in 1966 as part of the Federal Highway Beautification Act of 1965. This parcel is the former Shelburne Rest Area and was utilized as such until 2012 when the facility was closed.

Pursuant to RSA 4:39-c, this disposal was reviewed by the Department and determined to be surplus to its operational needs and interests. The sale will include the following conditions:

- Only one access point will be granted to this parcel. The buyer shall obtain a driveway permit through the Department's District 1 Office which shall comply with the Department's Driveway Permit Policy.
- The Grantee will be required to solicit a NH Licensed Land Surveyor to survey and prepare a Right of Way Adjustment and Subdivision plan to be submitted to the Department and the Town of Shelburne for review and approval. Upon approval by the Department, the Buyer is required to record the plan in the Coos County Registry of Deeds, from which the Department will prepare the conveyance deed. The Buyer will supply a full size copy of the recorded plan and draft description of the surveyed parcel.


On June 21, 2021 the Long Range Capital Planning and Utilization Committee, approved the Department's request (LRCP 21-024) to enter into a listing agreement with Badger Realty to market and sell the subject property for \$95,000.00, and to assess the \$1,100.00 administrative fee. Their approval authorized the Department to compensate Badger Realty a 6% commission for the sale.

Badger Realty marketed the subject property and brought all offers to the Department for consideration. On October 4, 2021, the Department entered into a Purchase and Sale Agreement with William F. Misek for \$95,000.00, plus the \$1,100.00 administrative fee to be collected at closing.

Pursuant to RSA 4:39-c, the Department has solicited interest from the Town of Shelburne who declined the offer. Pursuant to RSA 204-D:2, the Department also solicited interest from the New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority with no response.


The Department respectfully requests authorization to sell the subject parcel and compensate Badger Realty as noted above.





REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 4:39-c, the New Hampshire Department of Transportation (Department) requests approval to dispose of a 3.56 +/- acre parcel of State owned land, with improvements, located on the northerly side of US Route 2 in the Town of Shelburne. The Department will enter into a listing agreement for a term of one year with Badger Realty, with a 6% commission. The sale price for this parcel will be \$79,900.00, and the Department will assess an administrative fee of \$1,100.00, pursuant to RSA 4:40, III-A. The Department will allow negotiations within the Committee's past policy guidelines, subject to the conditions as specified in this request.

EXPLANATION

The Department proposes to dispose of 3.56 +/- acres of State owned land, with improvements, located on US Route 2 in the Town of Shelburne. The subject area is a portion of a larger parcel acquired in 1966, as part of the Federal Highway Beautification Act of 1965. This parcel is the former Shelburne Rest Area and was utilized as such until 2012 when the facility was closed.

After a departmental review, it was determined that the subject parcel is surplus to the Department's operational needs and is available for disposal. This parcel will be conveyed with the following conditions:

- Only one access point will be granted to this parcel. The buyer shall obtain a driveway permit, through the District 1 Office, which shall comply with the Department's Driveway Permit Policy.
- The buyer shall be responsible for submitting a Perimeter Boundary Survey/Right of Way Adjustment plan, prepared at their expense, by a land surveyor licensed in the State of New Hampshire, describing the parcel being conveyed. The Department will use this survey to prepare deeds for the sale of this parcel.
- Appropriate conditions shall be incorporated into the sale of the property to maintain the character defining features that make the property eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

In accordance with Tra 1000, "Process for Marketing and Sale of State Owned Property Utilizing Real Estate Professionals," and Tra 1003.03 (Selection Process), all pre-qualified Realtors in Region 1 (Carroll, Coos and Grafton Counties) were sent a request to submit a market analysis for the subject property at a real estate commission of 6%. Based on this request, the Department received responses from following firm:

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The Pre-Qualification Committee reviewed the above information and felt that a value of \$79,900.00 was an appropriate value for this property and selected Badger Realty to market the property, on behalf of the Department.

The Department will solicit interest in the property with the Town of Shelburne, pursuant to RSA 4:39-c and the New Hampshire Housing Finance Authority, pursuant to RSA 204-D:2.

The Department is respectfully requesting authorization to sell the subject parcel, as outlined above.

This is to be construed as an unequivocal *Exclusive Right to Sell/Lease* between the Seller and the undersigned Firm.

1. The undersigned seller (including owner, heirs, personal representatives, administrators and assigns), New Hampshire Department of Transportation ("SELLER"), hereby gives the undersigned Badger Realty ("FIRM"), on this date, _____, in consideration of FIRM'S agreement to list and promote the sale, lease or exchange of property located at R35 US RT 2, Shelburne (former Rest Area) owned by SELLER consisting of 3.56 +/- acres with improvements and including any other property, real or personal, subsequently added thereto, recorded in the Cook County Registry of Deeds in Book 498 Page 5 ("PROPERTY"), the exclusive right to sell, lease or exchange said PROPERTY at a price of \$ \$79,900.00 on the terms herein stated, or at any other price and terms to which SELLER may authorize or consent. If, during the term of this Agreement, an individual or entity is procured who is ready, willing and able to purchase at said price, or upon another price and terms to which SELLER may agree, then SELLER agrees to pay FIRM a commission of 6 % of the contract price or of the lease amount or _____

2. THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE IN EFFECT from 8/2/2021 through 8/2/2022. Upon full execution of a contract for sale and purchase of the PROPERTY, the expiration date of this Agreement shall automatically be extended to the closing date specified in the Purchase and Sales Agreement and shall remain that date even if the contract is extended. It is understood that unless otherwise indicated below, FIRM will enter this listing into the Northern New England Real Estate Network Multiple Listing Service or any other appropriate multiple listing service (collectively "MLS") within 48 hours, which information shall be distributed electronically and by other means. The commission as provided above shall also be due if the PROPERTY is contracted to be sold or has been sold, leased, conveyed, exchanged or otherwise transferred within 6 months after the expiration or rescission of this Agreement to anyone whom FIRM has procured, unless the PROPERTY has been listed with another licensed broker on an exclusive basis. "Procurement" shall include, but not be limited to, providing information about the PROPERTY, showing the PROPERTY, or presenting offers on the PROPERTY. PURCHASE AND SALES AGREEMENT

Upon approval of Governor and Council ("EFFECTIVE DATE")
EFFECTIVE DATE is defined in Section 21 of this Agreement.

1. THIS AGREEMENT made this 30 day of September between Department of Transportation ("SELLER") of 7 Hazen Drive, PO Box 483, Concord, NH 03302, and William F. Misek ("BUYER") of 8 Kendrick Street Nashua, NH 03084-2234

2. WITNESSETH: That SELLER agrees to sell and convey, and BUYER agrees to buy certain real estate situated in the City/Town of Shelburne, located at: 835 Route 2 and recorded in Coos County Book 498, Page 5 Dated March 8, 1866 ("PROPERTY").

3. The SELLING PRICE is Ninety-five Thousand Dollars \$95,000.00, plus an \$1,100.00 administrative fee. A DEPOSIT in the form of a Personal check is to be held in an escrow account by ("SELLER"). BUYER X has delivered, or will deliver to the ESCROW AGENT's FIRM within days of the EFFECTIVE DATE, a deposit of earnest money in the amount of \$9,500.00. If said deposit is to be delivered after this Offer is accepted by SELLER and is not delivered by the above deadline, this Agreement shall automatically terminate. BUYER agrees that an additional deposit of earnest money in the amount of \$ N/A will be delivered on or before N/A. Failure by BUYER to deliver this additional deposit shall constitute a default under this Agreement. The remainder of the purchase price shall be paid by wire certified cashier's or trust account check in the amount of \$85,500.00

4. DEED: Marketable title shall be conveyed by a Quitclaim Deed.

6. TRANSFER OF TITLE: On or before December 31, 2021 at Badger Realty or some other place of mutual consent as agreed to in writing.

6. POSSESSION: Full possession and occupancy of the premises, shall be given upon the transfer of title free of all tenants and occupant's personal property and encumbrances except as herein stated. Said premises to be then in the same condition in which they now are, reasonable wear and tear excepted. SELLER agrees that the premises will be delivered to BUYER free of all debris and in "broom clean" condition. Exceptions: Buyer reserves the right to conduct a walk through inspection upon reasonable notice to the SELLER within 48 hours prior to time of closing to ensure compliance with the terms of this Agreement.

7. REPRESENTATION: The undersigned SELLER(S) and BUYERS(S) acknowledge the roles of the agents as follows: Don Lepointe of Badger Realty is a X seller agent buyer agent facilitator disclosed dual agent Nicole Little of Badger Realty is a seller agent X buyer agent facilitator disclosed dual agent. If agent(s) are acting as disclosed dual agents, SELLER and BUYER acknowledge prior receipt and signing of a Dual Agency Informed Consent Agreement.

NOTICE OF DESIGNATED AGENCY: If checked, notice is hereby given that BUYER is represented by a designated buyer's agent and SELLER is represented by a designated seller's agent in the same firm.

8. IN CASE OF LOSS: In case of complete or partial loss of the building on said premises this Agreement may be rescinded and the DEPOSIT refunded at the option of BUYER, if any such loss exceeds \$2,000.00. This is the only remedy available to BUYER should such loss occur.

9. TITLE: If upon examination of title it is found that the title is not marketable, SELLER shall have a reasonable time, not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of notification of defect (unless otherwise agreed to in writing), to remedy such defect. Should SELLER be unable to provide marketable title within said thirty (30) days, BUYER may rescind this Agreement at BUYER'S sole option, with full deposit being refunded to BUYER and all parties being released from any further obligations hereunder. SELLER hereby agrees to make a good faith effort to correct the title defect within the thirty (30) day period above prescribed once notification of such defect is received. The cost of examination of the title shall be borne by BUYER.

10. PRORATIONS: Taxes, condo fees, special assessments, rents, water and sewage bills and fuel in storage shall be prorated as of time and date of closing.

If BUYER does not notify SELLER that the results of an inspection are unsatisfactory within the time period set forth above, the contingency is waived by BUYER. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE. If the results of any inspection specified herein reveal significant issues or defects, which were not previously disclosed to BUYER, then:

(a) SELLER shall have the option of repairing or remedying the unsatisfactory condition(s) prior to transfer of title, so long as BUYER and SELLER both agree on the method of repair or remedy; or
