EXPLANATION

This request is being made to accept the FVPSA supplemental funding of the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Pub L. No. 117-2, Title II, Part 2, Section 2204. This particular funding will support the ability to prevent, prepare and respond to sexual assault survivors during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency. Prevention will be provided by using outreach and education to local rape crisis centers and sexual assault programs on strategies that reduce COVID-19 transmission. This money is to help disseminate educational materials and resources to local

rape crisis centers on precautions to prevent, contain or mitigate COVID-19 and other respiratory illness. The funding will assist in the ability to continue to provide virtual services, temporary housing options, and supportive services to survivors of sexual assault. This funding will help prepare activities and technical assistance that includes assessing the needs of sexual assault survivors during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency. It will also provide/ensure continuity of rape crisis centers and sexual assault services, assessing capacity of local rape crisis sexual assault programs and plans to address the needs of survivors while reducing exposure and risk of contracting the COVID-19 virus. Funding will continue or expand remote services, virtual service and mobile advocacy. It will overall help maintain capacity of services to survivors of sexual assault in recovery from effects of violence during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency by responding to issues such as adapting to fluctuating needs and changing circumstances, staff enhancements, workforce supports and workforce capacity.

Funds are being budgeted in Class 074 (Grants for Pub Assist & Rel). The funds will be used to contract for outreach and education.

Funds are being budgeted for Audit costs (Class 041) per state requirements.

Area served: Statewide

Source of funds: These funds are 100% Federal from the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families.

In the event that these Federal Funds become no longer available, General Funds will not be requested to support this program.
