Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to reappoint Jeffery A. Strelzin (Position #9U350, Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-2611-013-500132) to a position where he will remain as an Assistant Attorney General at a salary of \$120,000, for a term ending December 29, 2026, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval.

EXPLANATION

Mr. Strelzin is a resident of Concord and a member of the New Hampshire Bar. He received a Bachelor of Science from Keene State College in 1986 and his Juris Doctor from the University of New Hampshire School of Law (formerly known as Franklin Pierce Law Center) in 1991. He served as a law clerk for the New Hampshire Superior Court from 1991 through 1993 and as an Assistant County Attorney at the Merrimack County Attorney's Office from 1997 to 2001. He joined the Department in 2001 and was assigned to the Criminal Justice Bureau. He was appointed Senior Assistant Attorney General and Chief of the Homicide Unit in 2004, and Associate Attorney General and Director of Public Protection in 2018. He will continue to serve in that capacity, and his salary will remain the same. A copy of his resume is attached.

RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.
