REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to the provisions of RSA 14:30-a, VI, Additional Revenues, authorize the Department of Health and Human Services, Division for Children, Youth and Families Bureau of Child Protection, to accept and expend federal Family Violence Prevention and Services Act (FVPSA) Grant – American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) of 2021; Subtitle E, in the amount of \$1,829,268 from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families for the Family Violence Prevention program, effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Executive Council approval through June 30, 2023, and further authorize the allocation of these funds in the accounts below. 100% Federal Funds.

The funding will also assist in expanding transportation services for survivors of domestic violence and their children, in accessing public health services: such as doctors, clinics,

It will overall help maintain capacity of services to survivors of domestic violence in recovery from effects of violence during the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency by responding to issues such as adapting to fluctuation complex needs and changing circumstances, staff enhancements, workforce supports and workforce capacity.

Funds are being budgeted in Class 074 (Grants for Pub Assist & Rel) and will be used to continue to provide and expand virtual services, temporary housing options, and supportive services to survivors of domestic violence and their children. Funds are also being budgeted for Audit costs (Class 041) per state requirements.

Source of funds: These funds are 100% Federal from the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children and Families.
