**REQUESTED ACTION**

Pursuant to RSA 4:8, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police to accept the donation of three (3) LG 32UD60-B and one (1) 34WP500 monitors with a value of approximately \$1,196.00 from The ATOM Group LLC to be used by the Division of State Police, NH Information Analysis Center (NHIAC). Effective upon Governor and Council approval.

**EXPLANATION**
