EXPLANATION

The Administrator III, Business Systems Analyst II and Training Development Manager positions were created and assigned to the Division for Behavioral Health to support the planning, implementation, improvement and maintenance for the Critical Time Intervention (CTI) program. Pursuant to Chapter 91, Laws of 2021, CTI was a recommendation from the Alvarez & Marsal financial review, and identified as one of the transformation projects. The CTI program was identified as a desired program due to key outcomes associated with the model including minimize readmissions to psychiatric hospitals, reduce state costs, and improve the model of care through evidence based practices. The above positions allow for the leadership and continuity in program work to accomplish the key outcomes of the CTI model
