REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant a salary increment to Eric W. Shirley (Position #9U372, Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-2615-014-500134) from a salary level of \$66,690.00 (LG BB, Step 3) to a salary level of \$70,538.00 (LG BB, Step 4), effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or January 27, 2023, whichever is later.
