REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to the provisions of RSA 21-I:54, authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources **Retroactively** continue one full-time Maintenance Mechanic III, Position #8T2945, salary grade 14, effective upon Governor and Council approval for the period of November 30, 2022 through November 30, 2023. 100% Other Funds.

Funding is available in account, Cannon Mountain, Cannon Operations, for Fiscal Year 2023 and is anticipated to be available in Fiscal Year 2024, upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget as follows.

EXPLANATION

This request is **retroactive** because the Maintenance Mechanic III, position #8T2945 ended on November 30, 2022 and due to an administrative oversight as this position was not included for review and continuation in review of our budget development process. For this reason, we are requesting retroactive approval.

This position is essential for the effective and efficient operations of Cannon Mountain and Franconia Notch State Park (Cannon/FNSP). This position supports a variety of mechanical and engineering maintenance services in the areas of Tramway, mobile machinery, and other critical operational components of the overall system operations. Granting approval of this position extension will allow the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources to continue to provide the needed direct support to maintain service operations at Cannon/FNSP. For this reason, we seek to continue employment of the position.
