EXPLANATION


This request is for authorization to pay membership dues to the National Association of State EMS Officials (NASEMSO). The association is the lead national organization for Emergency Medical Services (EMS), a respected voice for national EMS policy with comprehensive concern and commitment for the development of effective, integrated, community-based, universal, and consistent EMS systems.

Listed below are answers to standard questions required for Governor and Council organization dues and membership approval submissions:

1. *How long has this organization been in existence and how long has the agency been a member of this organization?* NASEMSO was formed in 1980 and New Hampshire has been a member for over twenty years.
2. *Is there is no other organization which provides the same or similar benefits which your agency belongs to?* No
3. *How many other state's belonging to this organization and is your agency the sole New Hampshire state agency that is a member?* There are 56 total entities that belong to this organization; 50 States as well as the District of Columbia and the 5 territories.
4. *How is the dues structure established? (Standard fee for all states, based on population, based on other criteria, etc.)* The standard fee is \$3,500.00 for up to 10 State officials. There is a standard fee of \$250.00 each additional member.

5. *What benefit does the state receive from participating in this membership?* NASEMSO membership affords a variety of opportunities to participate in activities with state EMS officials. Benefits include: representation and advocacy on EMS issues; a twice-monthly newsletter with EMS issues updates; a professional journal; "mini-survey" short data collection projects on specific EMS issues; opportunities for committee service and networking; an Annual Meeting and Expo; the EMS Leadership Skills Workshop.
6. *Are training or educational research materials included in the membership? If so, is the cost included? Explain in detail.* Included in the membership dues are the following: a twice-monthly newsletter with EMS issues updates, a professional journal, "mini-survey" short data collection projects on specific EMS issues, an Annual Meeting and Expo; the EMS Leadership Skills Workshop.
7. *Is the membership required to receive any federal grants or required in order to receive or participate in licensing or certification exams? Explain.* This membership is not required to receive any federal grants or required in order to receive or participate in licensing or certification exams.
8. *Is there any travel included with this membership fee? Explain in detail any travel to include the number of employees involved, the number of trips, destination if known and purposes of membership supported trips.* There is no travel included with this membership fee.
9. *Which state agency employees are directly involved with this organization? (Indicate if they are members, voting members, committee members, and/or officers of the organization).* The state agency employees are directly involved with this organization are as follows: 1) Acting as State Director to organization, Bureau Chief Justin Romanello; 2) Acting as State Data Manager, Captain Richard Cooper; 3) Acting as State Health and Medical Preparedness Coordinator, Bureau Chief Justin Romanello; 4) Acting as State Medical Director, Dr. Joey Scollan; 4) Acting as State Alternate Member, Vicki Blanchard; 5) Acting as State Pediatric Emergency Care Coordinator, Anna Sessa; 6) Acting as State Personal Licensure Coordinator, Captain Kathy Doolan; 7) Acting as State Trauma Manager, Walter Trachim; 8) Acting as State Alternate Member, Director Justin Cutting. The two additional members haven't been added at this time due to positions being vacant.
10. *Explain in detail any negative impact to the State if the Agency did not belong to this organization.* NAEMSO is a nationally recognized organization that provides multiple benefits, as indicated above, to its members across the United States. At this time the organization has representation to all fifty States as well as the District of Columbia and the five territories. By electing to not participate in the organization we would lose the opportunity to collaborate with all of the other representatives on both daily and long-term operational needs. By not participating would also alienate our State from the rest of the country.
