### EXPLANATION

This request to accept and expend funds from the Office of Highway Safety will enable NH State Police to purchase Sotoxa Inc., Roadside Oral Fluid Testing collection devices. This equipment will be prioritized for use by the NH State Police Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) team in conjunction with the NH Drug Evaluation & Classification Program (DECP) Coordinator, in a Roadside Oral Fluid Testing evaluation phase of the Sotoxa Roadside Oral Fluid Drug Screening device, to be conducted during regular DRE evaluation training between February and March 2023.

The NH State Police shall, at the conclusion of this project, provide their results to the Office of Highway Safety for review. A report shall be made on the correlation between a DRE determination of drug classes encountered including Cannabis (THC), Amphetamine (d-Amphetamine), Benzodiazepines (Temazepam), Cocaine Metabolite (Benzoylecgonine), Methamphetamine and Opiates (Morphine).

This equipment will be prioritized for use by the NH State Police Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) team in conjunction with the NH Drug Evaluation & Classification Program (DECP) Coordinator, in a Roadside Oral Fluid Testing evaluation phase of the Sotoxa Roadside Oral Fluid Drug Screening device, to be conducted during regular DRE evaluation training between February and March 2023.

PERFORMANCE MEASURE: The NH State Police shall at the conclusion of this project, provide their results, and if the Highway Safety Performance Measure of an 85% correlation between a DRE determination of Cannabis (THC) and a result of the Oral Fluid Test has been achieved.
