REQUESTED ACTION


Pursuant to RSA 94:3, the Department of Safety, Office of the Commissioner, requests approval for an annual salary increase for John Marasco, Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles (Position #9U064), in the amount of \$6,006.00 from a current salary of \$115,492.00 (LG II, Step 5) to a new annual salary of \$121,498.00 (LG II, Step 6), effective February 24, 2023. 100% Other Funds.

EXPLANATION

RSA 94:3 "Yearly Service Increases", states in part: "upon recommendation of the appointing authority, the holder of any position mentioned in RSA 94:1-a shall be entitled to an annual increase in salary amounting to 1/6 of the difference between the minimum and maximum salary for said position but in no case shall the total salary exceed the maximum as herein established".

John Marasco was originally confirmed by the Executive Council as Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) on February 16, 2022 and was reappointed on October 4, 2022. Director Marasco oversees all functions of the DMV including driver licensing, registration, titles, financial responsibility and operations at 14 DMV locations across the state. He has demonstrated leadership and dedication to enhancing public safety on the roadways of New Hampshire by ensuring that drivers, vehicles, and service providers are properly credentialed and by providing resources for the maintenance of our roadway infrastructure.
