REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 21-I:54, authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources to continue one full-time temporary Supervisor III, Position #8T3104, salary grade 23, effective upon Governor and Council approval for the period of April 21, 2023, through April 11, 2024. 100% Other Funds.

Funding is available in account, Park Operations, for Fiscal Year 2023 and is anticipated to be available in Fiscal Year 2024, upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget as follows.

EXPLANATION

The Supervisor III, Position #8T3104, currently ends on April 11, 2023. This position is essential for the effective and efficient operations of our ocean lifeguards and inland lifeguards. The position is responsible for planning, organizing, and evaluating trainings and is responsible for rescue operations, personnel, equipment and coordinating as needed when operations include both State and local municipal safety organizations. Granting approval of this position extension will allow the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources to continue to provide the necessary support to maintain safety to both our ocean and inland park visitors and critical rescue operations as required. For this reason, we seek to continue employment of the position.
