INFORMATIONAL REPORT

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation (Department) has taken steps to formally dissolve the layout of the Bath-Lisbon, F-033-1(18), 10425 Project (Project).

The Department acquired several properties under the Project which are currently in a tax-exempt status. While the Project is no longer active there is still an approved highway layout for this Project that is required to be dissolved prior to the Department declaring these state-owned properties as surplus and available for sale. Upon the dissolution of the Project, the Department plans to market and sell these parcels, which will return them to the respective Town's tax rolls.

The status of the Project has been considered through prior cycles of public hearings on the Department's Ten-Year Plan. Additionally, the Department has had direct correspondence on November 21, 2022, with the communities involved regarding this intended dissolution and has received no contrary feedback.

Therefore, the Department is dissolving the layout established for the Bath-Lisbon, F-033-1(18), 10425.


