Pursuant to RSA 21-I:54, authorize the Department of Employment Security to continue two full-time temporary *Fraud Investigator* positions, Position 8T3060 and 8T3062, salary grade 21, effective upon Governor and Council approval or April 3, 2023, whichever is later, through April 2, 2024. 100% Federal Funds.

Funding is available in the following accounts for Fiscal Year 2023 and is anticipated to be available in Fiscal Year 2024, upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget.
