To His Excellency, the Governor, and the Honorable Executive Council:

I, William J. Cass, Commissioner of the New Hampshire Department of Transportation, in accordance with RSA 230:45, propose reconstruction and widening of US Route 2 in the Jefferson-Randolph area to add shoulders, and improve geometrics, to improve safety on the corridor.

Jefferson-Randolph, X-A004(489), 13602C

This project will reconstruct and widen a portion of US Route 2 to add shoulders and improve geometrics to improve the corridor's safety. The project begins 500 feet east of the intersection with Black Velvet Road in Jefferson, and continues easterly 2.3 miles to 900 feet west of the intersection with Valley Road in Randolph. The project will have an effect on historic properties.
