### REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 106-B:5, II, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, to restore 329.74 hours of sick leave to a Trooper who was unable to perform normal or routine duties due to a critical incident involving the death of a co-worker, from August 15, 2022 through December 28, 2022.

### EXPLANATION

On October 28, 2021, the Trooper was on scene at a motor vehicle accident that resulted in the death of a co-worker. The Division did not place this Trooper on administrative leave with pay as a result of this critical incident, as defined by RSA 106-B:5, II. The Trooper was out of work and utilizing sick leave from August 15, 2022 through December 28, 2022 while being treated for trauma associated with the critical incident. The Department respectfully requests authorization to restore 329.74 hours of sick leave used by the Trooper during this period of time.
