EXPLANATION

This request is retroactive due to an internal change in how these grants are processed to ensure Executive Council approval of all awards that result exceed a cumulative amount of \$10,000 throughout the Fiscal Year.

The grants listed above are awarded to local agencies across NH to attend training programs offered through the State Fire Academy that are authorized under the Homeland Security grant. These training programs are targeted to first responders to expand local capabilities in the areas of hazardous materials, technical rescue, incident command and EMS in the Warm Zone. These programs teach each of the participants the foundational knowledge that is needed to perform these skills on all hazards incidents throughout the State. These funds reimburse the local agencies for the cost of personnel salaries and benefits to either send students to authorized training programs or to backfill personnel so an on-duty member can attend training.

Highway Funds or General Funds will not be used to support this program should Federal Funds become unavailable.
