Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Eric Monty to Position #9U216 (Appropriation #02-20-20-201010-2620-013-500132) as an Assistant Attorney General at a salary level of \$83,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval, or August 25, 2023, whichever is later, for a term ending July 31, 2028.

EXPLANATION

Mr. Monty, a Nashua resident, earned his Bachelor of Arts, magna cum laude, from Southern New Hampshire University in 2006, and a Master of Science in Political Science, Professional Politics, from Suffolk University in 2011. Following graduation from college and while in graduate school, he began working with non-profit organizations in the Boston area. He was a Campaign Associate for Project Bread – The Walk for Hunger (2007), an Intern with Clean Water Action Massachusetts' Elections Division (2010), and Communications Ambassador for the Young Nonprofit Professionals Network (2011-2012). He spent five years working at the Pine Street Inn – first as Development Associate/Researcher (2007-2011) and then as Communications and Development Officer (2011-2012). Mr. Monty enlisted in the U.S. Army in 2012 and served as a Cryptologic Linguist and Mission Manager. His training included studies at the Defense Language Institute in Monterey, California, where he earned an Associate of Arts in Pashto (2014). His individual military awards include the Joint Service Achievement Medal, Army Achievement Medal, and Military Outstanding Volunteer Service Medal. After being honorably discharged from the Army in 2017, Mr. Monty earned his Juris Doctor, summa cum laude, from the University of New Hampshire School of Law in 2020. During law school he was a Daniel Webster Scholar, Warren B. Rudman Fellow, Phi Alpha Delta Mock Trial Champion (2017), Legal Analysis and Writing Teaching Assistant (2018-2019), and Moot Court Chief Justice (2019-2020). He served as a Law Clerk for the New Hampshire Superior Court



after graduating from law school. Mr. Monty joined the Department in 2022 and was assigned to the Criminal Justice Bureau's Medicaid Fraud Control Unit. He will be transferred to the Civil Law Bureau's Litigation Unit and his salary will increase by \$3,000 from \$80,000 to \$83,000. A copy of his resume is attached.

RSA 21-M:3 and RSA 94:1-a provide that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.

I am pleased to offer Mr. Monty's appointment as an Assistant Attorney General at the above-referenced salary for your approval and respectfully urge your favorable consideration. Thank you.
