

Chad S. Lavoie was promoted to State Police Major on September 9, 2022. State Police Major's are assigned to the S416 wage schedule and are considered unrepresented positions. Per RSA 99:10-a State Police Major's are to receive a differential pay of \$25 per week unless otherwise collectively bargained. Due to the wage schedule assignment of the State Police Major positions, the differential was not applied correctly, resulting in underpayment to Major Lavoie for the period of September 9, 2022 to September 7, 2023.
