Effective upon Governor and Council approval. 41% Highway Funds, 34% General Funds 25% Turnpike Funds.



### EXPLANATION

Matthew S. Shapiro was promoted to State Police Executive Major on February 16, 2018. State Police Major's are assigned to the S416 wage schedule and are considered unrepresented positions. Per RSA 99:10-a State Police Major's are to receive a differential pay of \$25 per week unless otherwise collectively bargained. Due to the wage schedule assignment of the State Police Major position, the differential was not applied correctly, resulting in underpayment to Major Shapiro for the period of September 8, 2021 through September 7, 2023.
