REQUESTED ACTION

1. Authorize the Department of Agriculture, Markets, and Food (DAMF), Division of Agricultural Development to provide awards as indicated in the attached table, not to exceed a total of \$148,071.00 from the DAMF Crop Loss Program to six (6) recipients effective upon Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2024. EXPLANATION

On February 21, 2024, Governor and Executive Council approved the funding for the New Hampshire Department of Agriculture, Markets, and Food Crop Loss Program (Item #59) for the purpose of providing one-time emergency assistance to agricultural operations that experienced significant crop loss due to frosts, freezes, or significant weather-related events between January 1 and November 1 of 2023.


DAMF is accepting applications from eligible farms on a rolling basis through May 15, 2024. Requests for award authorizations for those over \$10,000 will be submitted to the Governor and Executive Council in "batch" approval requests.

The Award shall be administered through advance payments of 50 percent of eligible award amount upon Governor and Executive Council approval. At the conclusion of the program (May 15, 2024) total approved awards will be calculated. If the total of all eligible awards exceeds funding, remaining disbursements will be prorated for all awardees.

Within the total awards issued by DAMF in this batch, awards not to exceed \$148,071.00 are being submitted for approval by Governor and Executive Council as part of this request because they exceed the \$10,000 per entity threshold. Attached you will find a cumulative list of awards issued.

Crop Loss Program

Eligibility and Program Instructions

The New Hampshire Department of Agriculture, Markets, and Food (DAMF) Crop Loss Program will provide up to \$8 Million in relief in response to weather-related damages of 2023. The program, developed in collaboration with staff from UNH Cooperative Extension, is designed to help New Hampshire farmers who suffered significant crop losses as a result of extreme weather conditions which negatively impacted farms during 2023.

Starting March 1, 2024, eligible farms can apply for awards intended to account for 50% of net farm loss with a maximum award of \$500,000. Approved applications will be awarded 50% of their total award upon approval by Governor and Executive Council and final award amounts will be calculated after **the program closes on May 15, 2024**.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the DAMF Crop Loss Program your farm must meet the following criteria:

- Shall be principally located in New Hampshire,
- Have been in operation since at least January 1, 2022,
- Have total 2022 gross receipts of at least \$30,000,
- Experienced a minimum of 30 percent crop loss from one or more of the 2023 weather events,
- The events for which relief is sought must have occurred within New Hampshire's borders,
- Experienced a net loss in farm income for 2023 (an allowance of 5% of gross revenue up to \$60,000 for owner/operator labor will be calculated towards net income), and
- Have not permanently closed or currently in bankruptcy.
- Have and submit the following tax forms relevant to your operation:
 - Sole proprietors and partnerships should submit copies of IRS Schedule F (Form 1040) ***Profit or Loss from Farming***.
 - Partnerships should also submit copies of IRS Form 1065, ***U.S. Return of Partnership Income***.
 - Corporations need to submit copies of either ***Form 1120-S U.S. Income Tax Return for an S Corporation*** or ***Form 1120 U.S. Corporation Income Tax Return***.
