The Department of Transportation requests placing this item on the Consent Calendar.

Under RSA 230:14, attached is a petition for a public hearing to replace the Red List bridge that carries NH Route 32 over Martin Brook (Br. No. 149/072). The proposed replacement bridge would provide a longer span than the existing structure. NH Route 32 road improvements would include approximately 700 feet of roadway widening and realignment.

Since the petition is not for the limitation or control of access, a Commission of Three Persons should be appointed by the Governor with the advice of the Executive Council to hold a public hearing. The Commission shall determine whether there is an occasion for the replacement of the above-mentioned bridge, and roadway improvements.
