REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI authorize the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, to accept and expend an additional \$223,140.00 of federal funds from the Department of Safety, Office of Highway Safety entitled NHSP Radar for the purpose of purchasing one hundred sixteen (116) Kustom Signals Eagle 3 Radar. Effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval through September 30, 2024. Funding Source: 100% Intra Agency Transfers.

EXPLANATION

In an effort to perform effective speed enforcement on roads throughout the state, the NH State Police will purchase one hundred sixteen (116) Kustom Signals Eagle 3 Radar speed-measuring devices. This equipment will help to provide the tools necessary for use in speed enforcement, to minimize the potential of speed related crashes and the resulting injuries and fatalities on the roadways in the State of New Hampshire.

The funds are to be budgeted as follows:

Funds in Class 30 are needed to purchase one hundred sixteen (116) Kustom Signals Eagle 3 Radar speed-measuring devices.

Although the Department included this grant in the SFY 2024 budget, the amount of the Federal grant received is higher than what was budgeted, therefore requiring the above requested action. If this request is not approved Federal funds could be lost, therefore the above requested action is needed to fully utilize the federal grant funds.



SCOPE OF WORK: This amendment provides funding for the New Hampshire State Police to purchase 116 Kustom Signals, Inc. Eagle 3 Dual Ka-band antenna with Same Direction, Fastest, Scan Mode, Wireless Speed Sensing, Quick Trak, and eFork at \$2,915.00 per unit, as described in the quote provided by Kustom Signals, Inc., dated 3/20/24. This equipment will be prioritized for installation in new State Police cruisers purchased in 2024 to help provide the NH State Police with the necessary tools for use in speed enforcement, in order to minimize the potential of speed related crashes and the resulting injuries and fatalities on the roadways in the state of New Hampshire.


The NH State Police is required to provide documentation to the NHOHS that equipment to be purchased is Buy America Compliant. The NHOHS will reimburse the NH State Police 100% of the purchase price, up to \$338,140.00, for this speed enforcement equipment, 25% match required.

PERFORMANCE MEASURE: The NH State Police shall at the conclusion of this project, provide their results, and if the Highway Safety Performance Measure to reduce speed related crashes investigated by the State Police within their areas of operation by 5% has been achieved.




