REQUESTED ACTION

In accordance with Administrative Rules Adm 611.08 (g), the Department of Safety, Division of State Police, respectfully requests permission to increase its fleet size by two vehicles. Effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval.

EXPLANATION

Expanding the Division of State Police, Marine Patrol Bureau, by two vehicles to accommodate the creation of two new marine patrol officer positions is a strategic move. It ensures that the increased personnel have the necessary resources to effectively carry out their duties and responsibilities. By adding these two new cruisers, the Marine Patrol Bureau can enhance its coverage and response capabilities, contributing to improved safety and security in marine environments.

Additionally, having these vehicles can alleviate the workload and facilitate smoother operations for all officers in a proactive approach to addressing the evolving needs and demands of marine patrol law enforcement.

Funding for the vehicles is 100% Federal funds in Accounting Unit 02-23-23-234010-50460000-030 Recreational Boat Safety Grant. The purchase of these vehicles will be made as funding is available in the current biennium and the next biennium.

The Department of Administrative Services Fleet Management has been consulted and has conditionally approved this request pending Governor and Executive Council approval, as noted in the attached letter.


