REQUESTED ACTION


Pursuant to RSA 94:3, the Department of Safety, Office of the Commissioner, requests approval for an annual salary increase for Megan Hoskins, Assistant Director of the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (Position #9U522), in the amount of \$5,720.00 from a current salary of \$116,031.00 (LG GG, Step 6) to a new annual salary of \$121,751.00 (LG GG, Step 7), effective May 17, 2024. 35% General Funds, 35% Federal Funds, 30% Other Funds.

EXPLANATION

RSA 94:3 "Yearly Service Increases", states in part: "upon recommendation of the appointing authority, the holder of any position mentioned in RSA 94:1-a shall be entitled to an annual increase in salary amounting to 1/6 of the difference between the minimum and maximum salary for said position but in no case shall the total salary exceed the maximum as herein established".

Megan Hoskins was originally confirmed by the Executive Council as Assistant Director of the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management (HSEM) on May 5, 2023. Assistant Director Hoskins supports the Director of HSEM in overseeing the state-level planning, preparation, response to, recovery from and mitigation of all emergencies and disasters. This includes natural disasters such as hurricanes, floods and severe winter storms, and human-caused disasters, such as nuclear power plant accidents or chemical spills. Assistant Director Hoskins has demonstrated consistent leadership and dedication to the effective delivery of prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response, and recovery efforts for all hazards across the state of New Hampshire.
