REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 21-I:54, authorize the Department of Natural and Cultural Resources (Department) to **Retroactively** continue one full-time temporary 49-9070 GENERAL RPR WKRS-4 (*formerly a Plant Maintenance Engineer II*), Position #8T3136, SOC 49, Pay Band 4, effective upon Governor and Council approval for the period of October 14, 2023 through October 14, 2024. 100% Other Funds (Agency Income).

This request is **Retroactive** because the GENERAL RPR WKRS position #8T3136 ended on October 14, 2023 and as a result of an administrative oversight this position was not captured for review and continuation for 2024-2025.

This position is essential for the effective and efficient operations of Lake Francis State Park as well as Coleman State Park and DNCR recreational areas in the Great North Woods. This position is responsible for maintenance of buildings and infrastructure, as well as care and maintenance of power equipment used to perform maintenance of grounds, roads and trails within the state parks. Granting approval of this position extension will allow the Department to continue to provide the needed maintenance service it provides to our operations at Lake Francis and Coleman State Parks. For this reason, we seek to continue employment of the position.
