### REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 94:3, the Department of Safety, Office of the Commissioner, requests approval for an annual salary step increase for Mark Hall, Director of the Division of State Police (Position #9U068), in the amount of \$6,738.00 from a current salary of \$129,583.00 (Grade II, Step 5) to a new annual salary of \$136,321.00 (Grade II, Step 6), effective September 6, 2024.

### EXPLANATION

RSA 94:3 "Yearly Service Increases", states, in part, that "upon recommendation of the appointing authority, the holder of any position mentioned in RSA 94:1-a shall be entitled to an annual increase in salary amounting to 1/6 of the difference between the minimum and maximum salary for said position but in no case shall the total salary exceed the maximum as herein established".

Colonel Mark Hall was originally confirmed by the Executive Council as Director of the Division of State Police on September 6, 2023. Colonel Hall is charged with oversight of law enforcement on the State level, which includes seven Troop Stations, Marine Patrol, 28 State Police Units, NH Hospital Campus Police, and the Forensic Laboratory. He has demonstrated leadership and dedication to providing the highest degree of law enforcement service throughout the State of New Hampshire while maintaining the traditions of fairness, professionalism, and integrity.
