EXPLANATION

The Department of Education requests authorization to accept funds in the amount of \$1,000 from The Hearst Foundation to support selection expenses of the US Senate Youth Program (USSYP). In March of each year, this extremely competitive merit-based program brings 104 of the most outstanding high school students – two from each state, the District of Columbia and the Department of Defense Education Activity – to Washington, DC for an intensive week-long study of the federal government and the people who lead it. This year the USSYP Washington Week will be held March 1-8, 2025.


