Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to reappoint Matthew T. Broadhead to Position #9U488 (Appropriation #02-20-20-201010-2620-013-500132) as an Assistant Attorney General at a salary of \$125,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or September 29, 2024, whichever is later, for a term ending September 28, 2029.

EXPLANATION

Mr. Broadhead, a Windham resident and member of the New Hampshire Bar, earned his Bachelor of Arts, *cum laude*, from George Washington University in 2007, and his Juris Doctor, *cum laude*, from the University of New Hampshire School of Law in 2010, where he was a graduate of the Daniel Webster Scholar Honors Program. He practiced law as an associate attorney at Burns, Bryant, Cox, Rockefeller & Durkin, P.A. from 2010 to 2014. Joining the Department of Justice in 2014, he initially served as an Attorney and Assistant Attorney General in the Transportation and Construction Bureau. He transferred to the Civil Law Bureau and was named head of the Election Law Unit in 2017. In April 2019, he was designated as a Senior Assistant Attorney General and Chief of the Transportation and Construction Bureau. In 2023, he was designated as an Associate Attorney General and appointed Director of the Division of Legal Counsel. His assignment and salary will remain the same. His resume is attached.


