Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

**REQUESTED ACTION**

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Nancy A. DeAngelis to Position #9U750 (Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-2309-013-500132) as an Assistant Attorney General at a salary level of \$110,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or January 10, 2025, whichever is later, for a term ending July 1, 2028.

**EXPLANATION**

Ms. DeAngelis, a Salem resident, earned a Bachelor of Arts, with Distinction, in Government from Cornell University in 1992, Juris Doctor from Northeastern University School of Law in 1995, and Master of Science in Education in Instructional Technology from Kaplan University in 2014. After graduating law school, she joined the New Hampshire Public Defender where she served as Staff Attorney (1995-2000) and Managing Attorney (2000). She practiced as an Associate at Twomey & Sisti Law Offices (2000-2001) and Wiggin & Nouri, PA (2001-2004) before becoming Of Counsel with Robert A. Stein & Associates, PLLC (2004-2005). Ms. DeAngelis worked at RiverStone Resources, LLC, as Legal Audit Manager/Latent Case Manager (2005-2008) before opening Legal Resource Strategies, PLLC, later known as Nancy DeAngelis Law, PLLC (2008-2017). In addition to her legal career, she has held several positions in the education field including Senior Instructional Designer, Associate Professor, and Department Chair at Mount Washington College (2009-2015); Associate Director of Instructor Recruitment and Director of Program Development at Brandeis University (2016-2018); and Associate Vice President of Learning Solutions at Southern New Hampshire University (2018-2023). She is admitted to practice in New Hampshire and the United States Supreme Court. I plan to continue her assignment in the Consumer Protection and Antitrust Bureau's Elder Abuse and Financial Exploitation Unit. Her salary will increase by \$3,000 from \$107,000 to \$110,000.
