REQUESTED ACTION

Approve Lanes End Inc's request for a five-year permit time extension of NH Department of Environmental Services (NHDES) Wetland Bureau permit #2019-03309, to perform the following work on Lake Winnepesaukee in Melvin Village, in accordance with RSA 482-A:3, XIV-a. This project was previously approved by the Governor and Executive Council on March 25, 2020, Item #62. No comments were submitted by the Melvin Village Conservation Commission regarding the project as proposed.

Permanently replace five 16 inch x 20 foot finger piers and one 16 inch x 18 foot finger pier within an existing commercial marina with four 20.5 inch x 24 foot finger piers and one 20.5 inch x 20 foot finger piers, remove seven tie-off pilings, drive six new tie-off pilings, and repair all remaining structures in kind on an average of 810 feet of frontage along Lake Winnepesaukee on Haley's Point in Tuftonboro.

NHDES imposed the following conditions as part of this approval:

1. All work shall be in accordance with plans modified by Winnepesaukee Marine Construction dated January 9, 2020, as received by NHDES on January 10, 2020.
2. This permit is not valid and effective until it has been recorded with the appropriate county Registry of Deeds by the applicant. Prior to starting work under this permit, the permittee shall submit a copy of the recorded permit to the NHDES Wetlands Bureau by certified mail, return receipt requested.
3. All development activities associated with this project shall be conducted in compliance with applicable requirements of RSA 483-B and N.H. Code of Administrative Rules Env-Wq 1400 during and after construction.
4. Work shall be carried out in a time and manner to avoid disturbances to migratory waterfowl breeding and nesting areas.
5. Appropriate turbidity controls shall be installed prior to construction, shall be maintained during construction such that no turbidity escapes the immediate dredge area, and shall remain until suspended particles have settled and water at the work site has returned to normal clarity.
6. All construction-related debris shall be placed outside of areas subject to RSA 482-A jurisdiction.
7. Any subdivision of the property frontage will require removal of a sufficient portion of the docking structures to comply with the dock size and density requirements in effect at the time of the subdivision.
8. Only those structures shown on the approved plans shall be installed or constructed along this frontage. All portions of the structures, including the breakwater toe of slope, shall be at least 20 feet from the abutting property lines or the imaginary extension of those lines into the water.
9. This permit does not allow dredging for any purpose.

EXPLANATION

NHDES approved this project on January 28, 2025. NHDES supported its decision with the following findings:

1. Per Rule Env-Wt 314.05(d), as specified in RSA 482-A:3, XIV-a(a), the department finds the permittee has submitted the request as specified in Env-Wt 314.05(b) and (c) and the mitigation measures proposed by the permittee are adequate to protect public waters from deterioration. The department therefore grants one extension of 5 additional years for permit #2019-03309.
2. Per Rule Env-Wt 314.05(b), the permittee submitted a written request to the department for an extension of permit #2019-03309 prior to the expiration of the permit.
3. Per Rule Env-Wt 314.05(c)(2), the submitted request included a statement, signed and certified in accordance with Env-Wt 311.11, that: the permit for which extension is sought has not been revoked or suspended without reinstatement; extension of the permit would not violate a condition of law or rule; the project is proceeding towards completion in accordance with plans and other documentation referenced by the permit; the applicant proposes reasonable mitigation measures to protect the public waters of the state from deterioration during the period of extension; and the wetland delineation is still valid pursuant to Env-Wt 406.01(b).
4. Per Rule Env-Wt 314.05(d), as specified in RSA 482-A:3, XIV-a(a), the department finds the permittee has submitted the request as specified in Env-Wt 314.05(b) and (c) and the mitigation measures proposed by the permittee are adequate to protect public waters from deterioration. The department therefore grants one extension of 5 additional years for permit #2019-03309.

NHDES Wetlands Bureau permit #2019-03309 application documents are enclosed for review by the Governor and the Executive Council in consideration of this request and in accordance with RSA 482-A:3, II(a), as it is a major project located in New Hampshire public waters.

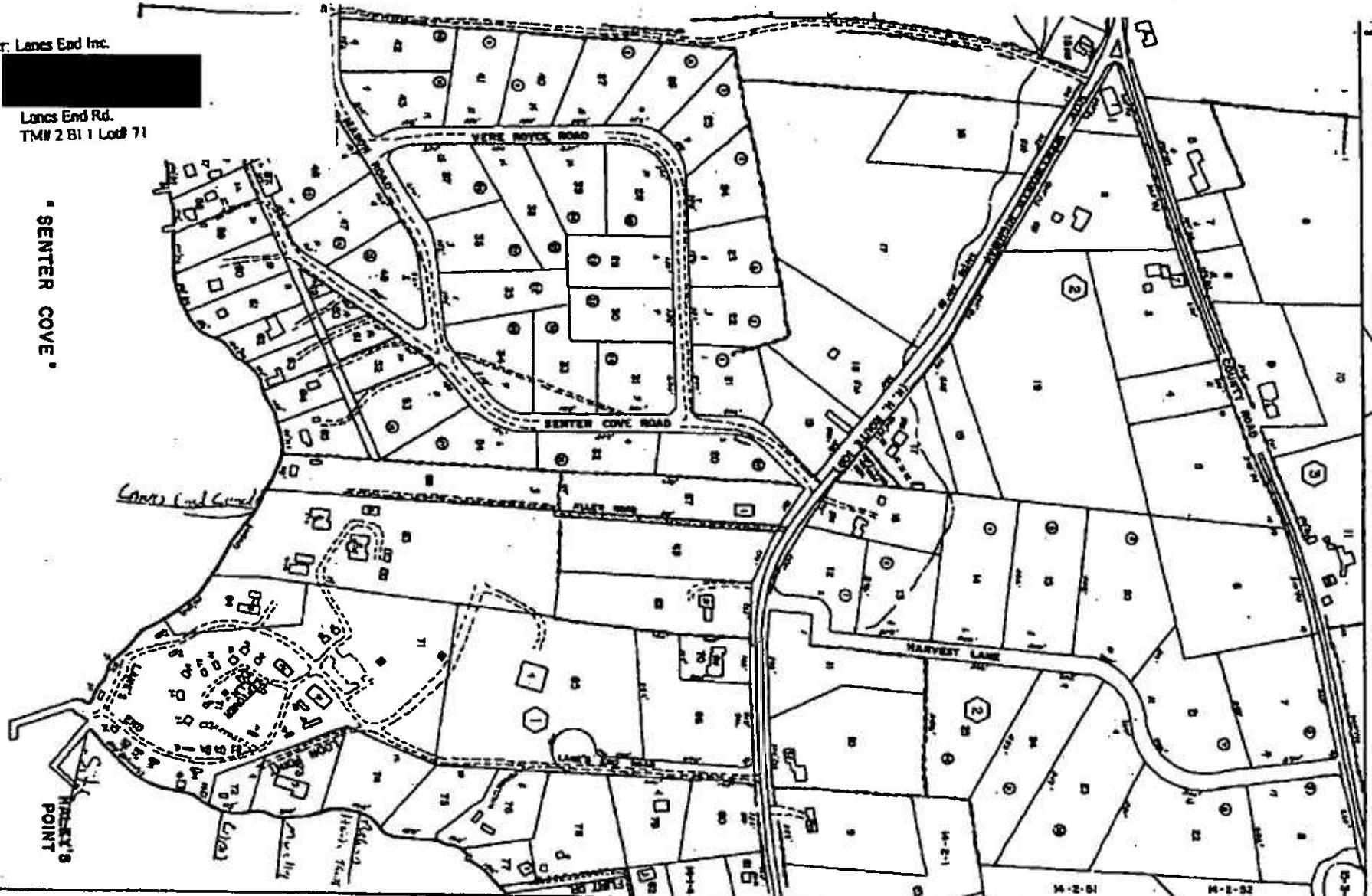

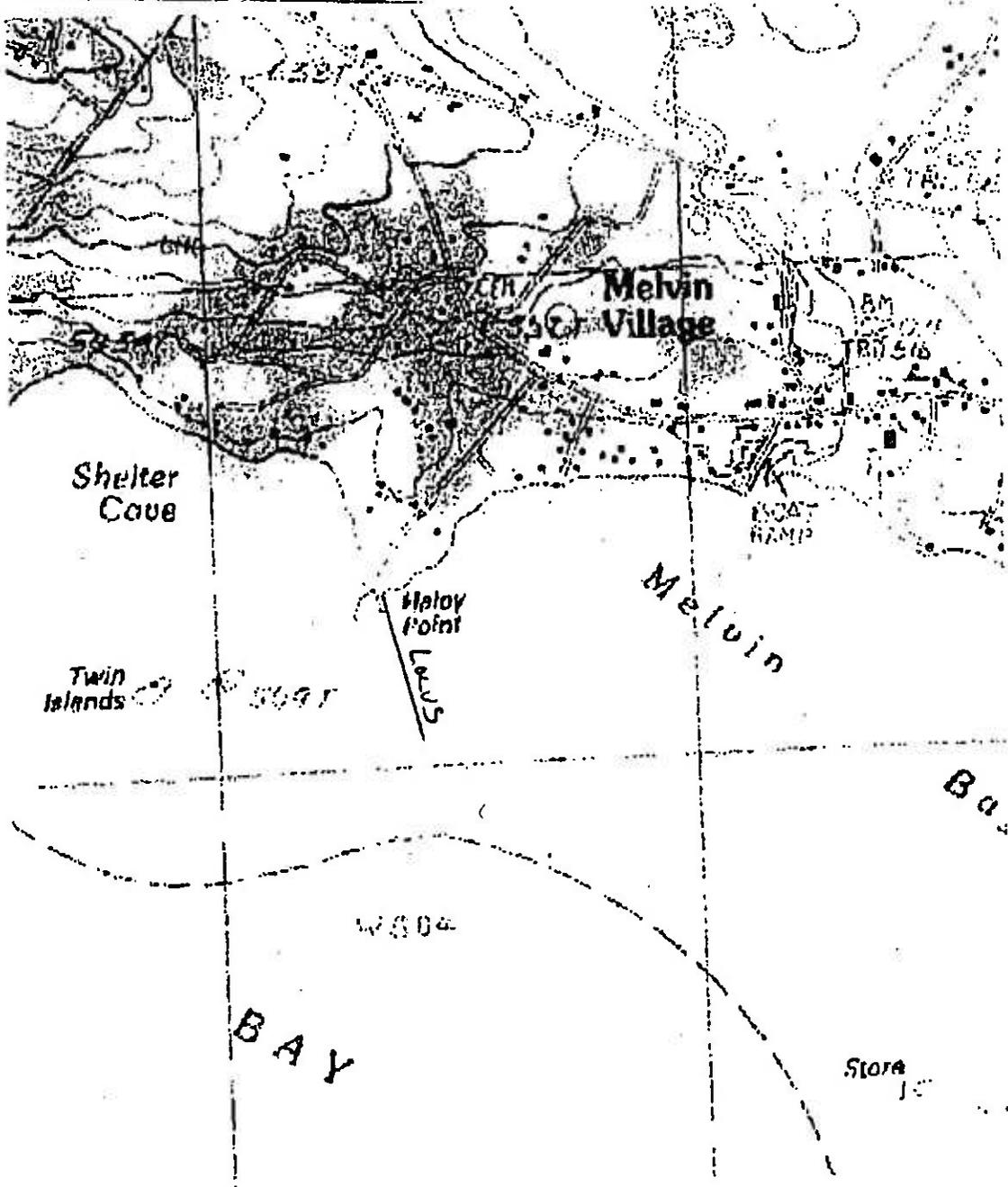

Project Description: Replace piling and reconfigure major docking facility

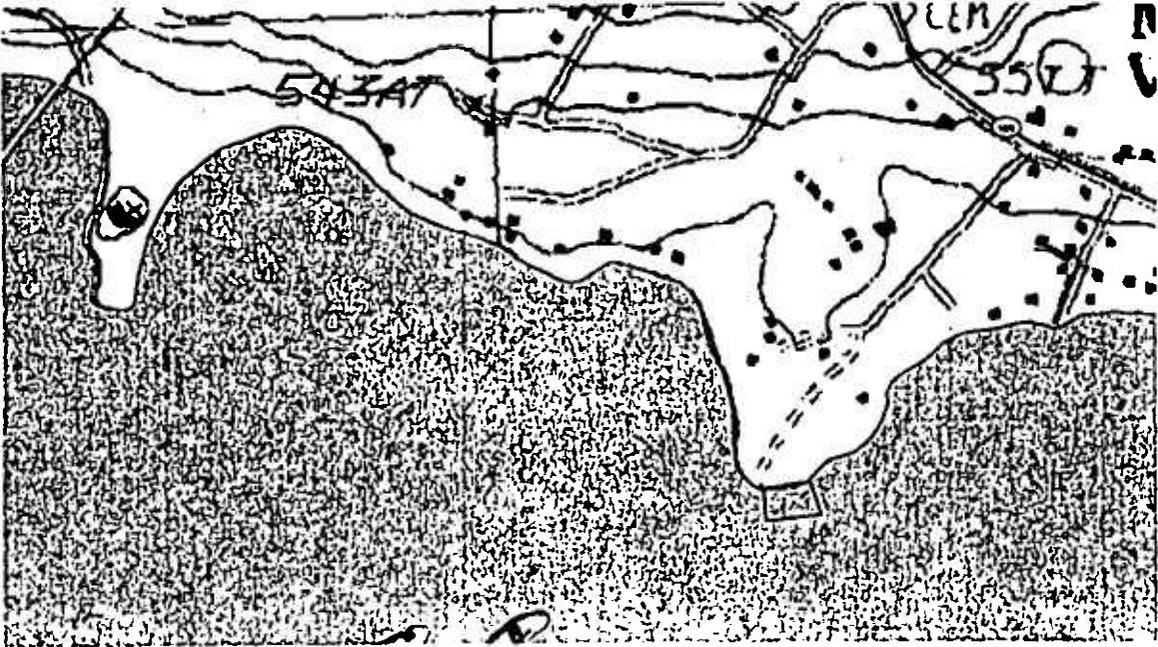
The NH Natural Heritage database has been checked for records of rare species and exemplary natural communities near the area mapped below. The species considered include those listed as Threatened or Endangered by either the state of New Hampshire or the federal government. We currently have no recorded occurrences for sensitive species near this project area.

A negative result (no record in our database) does not mean that a sensitive species is not present. Our data can only tell you of known occurrences, based on information gathered by qualified biologists and reported to our office. However, many areas have never been surveyed, or have only been surveyed for certain species. An on-site survey would provide better information on what species and communities are indeed present.

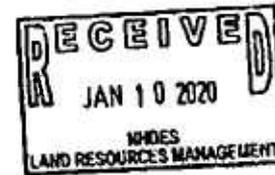

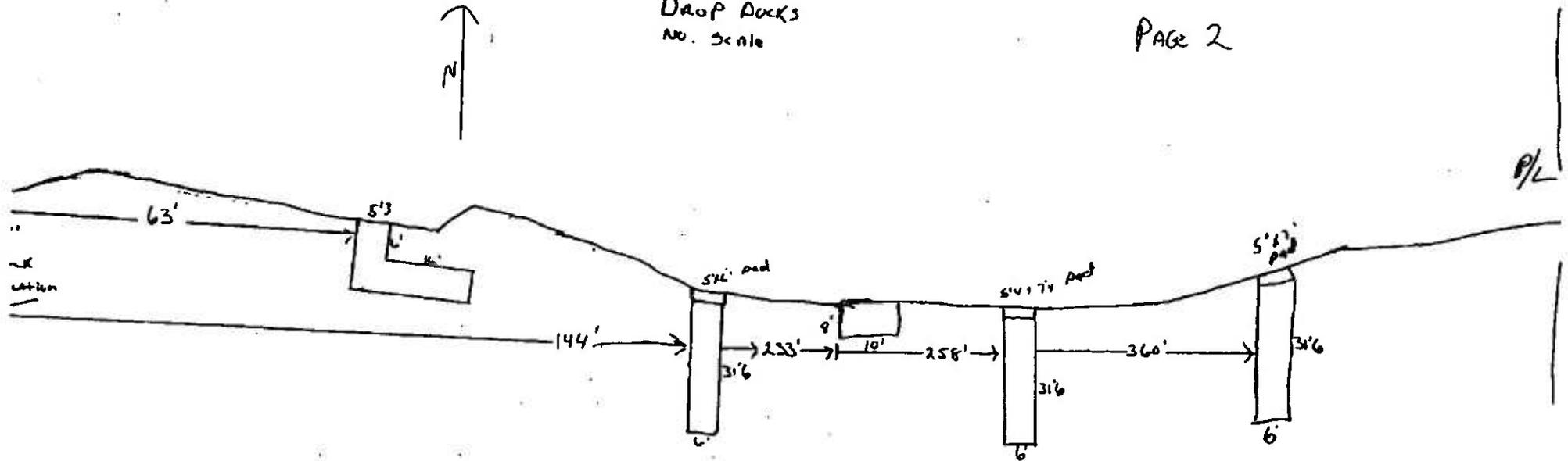
