Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint David Schreiner to Position #9U732 (Appropriation #02-20-20-202010-1037-014-500134), as an Assistant Deputy Medical Examiner, at a salary level of \$66,192 (Labor Grade BB, Step 1), effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval, or May 16, 2025, whichever is later.

EXPLANATION

Chapter 79 Laws of 2023 (HB2) established within the Department of Justice the unclassified position entitled Assistant Deputy Medical Examiner to be appointed by the Attorney General pursuant to RSA 21-M:3, XIV, and to serve at the pleasure of the Chief Medical Examiner pursuant to RSA 611-B:5.

Mr. Schreiner, a Franconia resident, received his Associate of Science (Criminal Justice) in 1985 from Delta College, a Bachelor of Science (Criminal Justice) in 1987 from Ferris State University, and a Master of Science (Technology Studies) in 2012 from Eastern Michigan University. He was a member of the Canton Police Department in Canton, Michigan from 1987 through 2014, where he rose through the ranks of Police Officer, Detective, Patrol Sergeant, Detective Bureau/Ordinance Division Supervisor, and finished his career there as a Shift Lieutenant. From 2014 through 2017, he worked for the Michigan State Police Western Wayne Criminal Investigations Task Force where he was a Property Manager/Forfeiture Case Manager. In 2018, he relocated to England, where he worked as a Customer Contact Service Agent for British Airways. In 2020, Mr. Schreiner moved back to New Hampshire, where he worked as a Warehouse Shipper/Receiver for Freudenberg-NOK. He has been working for the State of New Hampshire since 2021--first as an Investigator with the Department of Employment Security and, since 2022, as an Abstractor/Specialist II for the Department of Health and Human
