Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to grant a salary increase to Alexandra C. Sosnowski, as an Assistant Attorney General (Position #9U552, Appropriation #02-20-20-200510-2611-013-500132), in the amount of \$3,000, from a salary level of \$88,000 to a salary level of \$91,000, effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval or May 30, 2025, whichever is later.

EXPLANATION

Ms. Sosnowski is a Concord resident and a member of the New Hampshire and Maine Bars. She graduated in 2013 from the University of New Hampshire, *cum laude*, with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science and Justice Studies. She earned her Juris Doctor in 2017 from the University of New Hampshire School of Law where she had been a Daniel Webster Scholar, Teaching Assistant, and Rudman Summer Fellow. While in law school, Ms. Sosnowski completed summer internships with the New Hampshire Department of Justice, Consumer Protection and Anti-Trust Bureau, and the University of New Hampshire, Institute for Health Policy and Practice. Following graduation, she worked as Manager of Legal and Governmental Relations for Northeast Delta Dental where she was responsible for insurance and nonprofit regulatory compliance in Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont. Ms. Sosnowski joined the Department in April 2021 and was assigned to the Consumer Protection and Anti-Trust Bureau. She was commissioned as an Assistant Attorney General in May 2022. Since 2023, Ms. Sosnowski has led the Department's anti-trust team. This work has included successful review and resolutions in 3 major hospital acquisitions/mergers. During her time leading our anti-trust efforts, the Department has also established the Healthcare Consumer Protection Trust Fund and the Healthcare Consumer Protection Advisory Commission. In recognition of her performance with this Department, I have designated her a Senior Assistant

Attorney General. Her salary will increase by \$3,000 from \$88,000 to \$91,000. I plan to continue her current assignment.

RSA 21-M:3 and RSA 94:1-a(I)(c)(3) provides that designation of positions, salary levels, and salary increases for attorneys at the Department of Justice shall be determined by the Attorney General, subject to approval of the Governor and Council, within appropriations made to the Department of Justice.

I respectfully urge your favorable consideration of this request. Thank you.
