REQUESTED ACTION


Pursuant to RSA 21-1:29-a II, the Department of Safety, Office of the Commissioner, requests authorization to disburse to Mr. Connor Mark Haas, of Portsmouth, NH 03801, as the surviving adult child of deceased Security Officer Bradley Haas, death benefits in the amount of \$100,000 as a result of Security Officer's line of duty death on November 17, 2023. Effective upon Governor and Council approval. **100% General Funds.**

EXPLANATION

This request is to disburse the sum of \$100,000, the death benefit Security Officer Bradley Haas is entitled to under RSA 21-1:29-a, to the beneficiaries of Security Officer Bradley Haas, who died in the line of duty. On November 17, 2023, Security Officer Bradley Haas, while serving with the Division of State Police, was working his assigned shift at the New Hampshire Hospital located at 36 Clinton Street, Concord, NH. Security Officer Haas was assigned to check in visitors and staff entering the hospital through the main lobby. At 15:38 hours a subject armed with a handgun entered the main lobby of the hospital and immediately shot Security Officer Haas, which resulted in his immediate and untimely death. It has been determined that Security Officer's Haas death occurred in the line of duty.

Pursuant to Chapter 315, Laws of 2024, the State Treasurer shall pay a \$100,000 to the beneficiaries of Bradley Haas in the same manner and under the same terms and conditions as provided in RSA 21-1:29-a, II. The Governor, with the consent of the Executive Council, is authorized to draw a warrant for said sum out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated.
