
EXPLANATION

Mr. Foremny, an Epping resident, began his career in law enforcement at Glendale Police Department in Glendale, Arizona, where he worked in Neighborhood Patrol Services (1982 – 1988) and Investigations (1988 – 2004). Mr. Foremny received the Glendale Police Officer of the Year in 1994, and the Glendale Police Investigator of the Year in 2002. In 2004, he took a position with the Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections, where he worked as a Training Officer (2004), Special Investigator (2004 – 2007), Criminal Investigations Supervisor (2007 – 2012), and Internal Affairs Bureau Administrator (2012 – 2015). In 2015, he took a position with the Maricopa County Attorney's Office as a Cold Case Detective (2015 – 2022), and Trial Bureau Lieutenant (2022 – 2023), where he supervised nine investigators in support of criminal prosecution. He joined the Department in July 2023 as a part-time Criminal Justice Investigator in the Criminal Justice Bureau's Cold Case Unit. Given his years of experience and expertise, a salary of \$79,144 (LG BB, Step 4) is requested. His resume is attached for your consideration.
