INSTALLATION OF
THE NEW SCOREBOARD MODEL 3600, AT THE SPECIFIED LOCATION AS DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED
PLANS.

FOR THE SUCCESSFUL INSTALLATION OF THE SCOREBOARDS, INCLUDING SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS.

1. PROJECT OVERVIEW:

THE PROJECT INVOLVES THE INSTALLATION OF EITHER NEVCO MODELS 3618 OR 3619 OUTDOOR
MULTISPORT SCOREBOARD.
THE SCOREBOARD DIMENSIONS ARE 18' X 8' X 3/16" WITH A HANGING WEIGHT OF APPROXIMATELY 570
LBS WITHOUT
ETNS AND 632 LBS WITH ETNS. THE DIGIT SIZE IS 18", AVAILABLE IN HIGH INTENSITY RED, AMBER, OR
TRANSLUCENT
WHITE LEDS. PLEASE REFERENCE THE ATTACHED QUOTE FOR EXACT PRODUCT SPECIFICATIONS TO BE
PROVIDED.

2. LOCATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- REFERENCE ATTACHED SITE PLAN.
- THE INSTALLATION MUST ACCOUNT FOR WIND LOAD SPEED ZONES EXCEEDING 150 MPH.
- ENSURE PROPER SEALING TO REDUCE WATER INTAKE UTILIZING THE GASKETED DIGIT FEATURE.

3. STRUCTURAL AND ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS:

PROVIDE PRICING FOR INSTALLATION PER MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS. THE FOLLOWING
SUMMARY IS FOR
FAMILIARIZATION ONLY.

- FOUR (4) BRACKETS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR MOUNTING THE SCOREBOARDS. ENSURE THESE
BRACKETS ARE

SECURELY FIXED AS PER THE PROVIDED DIMENSIONS AND SPECIFICATIONS.

- A STEEL COLUMN FOUNDATION WITH PIERS, AS DETAILED IN THE FOUNDATION DRAWINGS, MUST BE
CONSTRUCTED

TO SUPPORT THE SCOREBOARDS. THE CONCRETE USED SHOULD MEET A MINIMUM OF 2500 PSI.

- ELECTRICAL REQUIREMENTS INCLUDE 120 VAC, 1.2 AMPS WITHOUT ETNS (2.2 AMPS WITH ETNS) OR 240
VAC, 0.6 AMPS WITHOUT ETNS (1.1 AMPS WITH ETNS), DEPENDING ON THE CHOSEN LED COLOR.

- CONDUCTOR SIZE TO BE CALCULATED BY THE INSTALLER TO MEET NEC REQUIREMENTS. CONDUCTOR SPECIFICATIONS TO BE PROVIDED TO THE NHARNG FOR VERIFICATION PRIOR TO PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION.

CONDUCTORS TO BE TIED INTO THE ELECTRICAL PANEL INSIDE THE FIELD HOUSE.

4. INSTALLATION STEPS:

PRODUCT TO BE INSTALLED PER MANUFACTURER'S SPECIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS. THE FOLLOWING SUMMARY IS FOR FAMILIARIZATION ONLY.

- STEP 1: PREPARE THE FOUNDATION AS PER THE DRAWINGS. THIS INCLUDES SETTING THE PIERS AND COLUMNS TO THE SPECIFIED DEPTH AND WIDTH.

- STEP 2: ENSURE THE SCOREBOARD IS INSTALLED WITHIN A 15-FOOT RADIUS OF THE EXISTING POLE BOXES.

- STEP 3: ASSEMBLE THE SCOREBOARD SECTIONS (TOP AND BOTTOM) ACCORDING TO THE PROVIDED INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS. THIS INCLUDES MAKING NECESSARY SIGNAL CONNECTIONS BETWEEN BOARD SECTIONS BEFORE INSTALLATION.

- STEP 4: ATTACH THE BRACKETS TO THE COLUMNS. USE THE SPECIFIED HARDWARE (3/8 X 1 1/2 BOLTS, FLAT WASHERS, LOCK WASHERS, AND NUTS) FOR BOLTING THE BRACKETS.

- STEP 5: INSTALL THE LOWER ROW OF SCOREBOARD CABINETS FIRST, USING EYE BOLTS FOR LIFTING AND ENSURING ALL BRACKET BOLTS ARE TIGHTENED.

- STEP 6: FOLLOW WITH THE INSTALLATION OF THE UPPER ROW OF CABINETS, MAKING POWER AND SIGNAL CONNECTIONS BEHIND ACCESS DOORS.

- STEP 7: FINALIZE BY ENSURING ALL CONNECTIONS ARE SECURE, AND THE SCOREBOARD IS LEVEL AND FLUSH WITH THE TOP OF THE COLUMNS.

5. ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS:

- ENSURE THAT ALL INSTALLATIONS CONFORM TO LOCAL BUILDING CODES AND STANDARDS, PARTICULARLY REGARDING WIND LOAD AND ELECTRICAL SAFETY. PULLING PERMITS WITH THE AHJ (STATE FIRE MARSHALLS OFFICE) IS REQUIRED AND

SHOULD BE CARRIED BY THE INSTALLING CONTRACTOR.

- ANY MODIFICATIONS TO THE DESIGN OR ADDITIONAL COMPONENTS ADDED TO THE DISPLAY SHOULD BE REVIEWED AND

APPROVED BY A CERTIFIED ENGINEER AT THE COST OF THE INSTALLER, THE MANUFACTURER, AND REVIEWED AND APPROVED BY THE NHARNG PROJECT MANAGER.

- VERIFY ALL BOLTS AND CONNECTIONS ARE SECURE AND MEET THE MINIMUM GRADE REQUIREMENTS.

- MISCELLANEOUS HARDWARE, CONNECTORS, CONSTRUCTION SEALANTS, LOAM & SEED, ETC. TO BE CARRIED AND PROVIDED BY THE INSTALLING CONTRACTOR.

- PRICING SHOULD BE INCLUSIVE OF ALL PERMITS, COMPONENTS, MATERIALS, AND SERVICES REQUIRED TO PROVIDE A

COMPLETE AND FUNCTIONAL PRODUCT THAT SECURES A MANUFACTURER'S WARRANTY. THE SURROUNDING SITE TO BE

RETURNED TO PRE-CONSTRUCTION CONDITION SUBJECT TO NHARNG PM'S APPROVAL.
