- 2) Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the Department of Energy to **retroactively** amend FIS 24-332 approved by the Fiscal Committee of the General Court on October 18, 2024 and item # 041 approved by the Governor and Executive Council on November 13, 2024 by extending the current end from June 30, 2025 to June 30, 2027 to accept and expend \$2,471,268 of Federal Funds from the United States Department of Energy, Bipartisan Infrastructure Law, Preventing Outages and Enhancing the Resilience of the Electric Grid, effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Executive Council approval. **100% Federal Funds**

**EXPLANATION**

The Department of Energy received these funds from the US Department of Energy's Preventing Outages and Enhancing the Resilience of the Electric Grid as a result of the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL). The amount awarded is based on a federal formula, with each state and territory receiving a set amount, provided the state or territory filed a compliant application. These funds will be used by the Department of Energy to provide grants to

electric distribution utilities in the state to complete improvements to their distribution systems that reduce the frequency and duration of outages. 
