REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to reappoint Dan Alan Jimenez to serve on the New Hampshire Victims' Assistance Commission. Mr. Jimenez will be serving a 3-year term upon approval of the Governor and Executive Council through June 1, 2028.

EXPLANATION

NH RSA 21-M:8-g authorizes the Attorney General to nominate, for approval by the Governor and Executive Council, members to serve on the New Hampshire Victims' Assistance Commission. It is the responsibility of the Commission to review claims for financial reimbursement of expenses submitted by innocent victims of violent crimes. This program has been in effect since 1990.

Mr. Jimenez is an accomplished attorney specializing in criminal law. He is currently employed as a Senior Assistant Attorney General in the criminal bureau with the New Hampshire Department of Justice. Mr. Jimenez's knowledge and expertise in criminal law will continue to benefit the operation of the Victims' Assistance Commission.

Currently assigned as the Chief of the Public Integrity Unit (“PIU”) in the Criminal Justice Bureau. The Public Integrity Unit investigates and prosecutes public officials and local law enforcement for criminal conduct. In addition to assignments directly within PIU’s mission, we prosecute priority cases as assigned by the Attorney General. I currently supervise 3 attorneys, 1 paralegal, and approximately 5 investigators. I have either supervised or been the first chair in investigations and prosecutions of homicide and corruption cases. These investigations/prosecutions included charges/indictments for thefts, witness tampering, and murder. Investigations included interviewing witnesses, assisting with search warrants, questioning witnesses before the grand jury, and obtaining records from public and private entities. Litigation included extensive motion practice and jury trials. I am also assigned as a Senior Assistant Attorney General to review and maintain the Exculpatory Evidence Schedule.

Massachusetts Attorney General’s Office, Boston, MA

Assistant Attorney General-February 2019-November 2020

Assigned to the Insurance and Unemployment Fraud Unit in the White Collar and Public Integrity Division tasked with investigating and prosecuting insurance fraud and public integrity crimes. Presented cases to grand juries across the state involving complex theft schemes. All cases involved motion practice and negotiated pleas. Litigated Henry hearings after negotiated plea agreements.

Plymouth County District Attorney’s Office, Brockton, MA

Assistant District Attorney-January 2013-February 2019

Tried over forty jury trials and over fifty bench trials. Submitted briefs and successfully argued in front of the Massachusetts Appeals Court. The types of cases assigned ranged from motor vehicle homicides to sexual assaults. In addition to litigation, I supervised the Brockton District Court, Wareham District Court, and Plymouth District Court. Oversaw all cases originating out of the courts I supervised. Served as liaison to judges, defense bar, and court staff on behalf of the District Attorney. Recommended, prepared, and presented cases to the grand jury.
