REQUESTED ACTION

Pursuant to RSA 14:30-a, VI, authorize the Department of Safety, Division of Fire Safety to accept and expend funds from the 2024 Homeland Security Grant Program, in the amount of \$125,000.00. This funding will be awarded to the Regional Hazardous Materials Response Teams to conduct standardized training for hazardous materials technicians statewide. This will be effective upon Fiscal Committee and Governor and Council approval through June 30, 2027. **100% Intra-Agency Transfer.**
