REQUESTED ACTION

Authorize the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to enter a contract with Raymond's Landscaping LLC (VC# 223766) Concord, New Hampshire, for a total price not to exceed \$885,000 for excavation services in the following New Hampshire Counties: Belknap, Carroll, Cheshire, Coos, Grafton, Hillsborough, Rockingham, Strafford and Merrimack, with the option to renew for an additional two-year period. The term of the contract shall begin on October 1, 2025, or upon approval of the Governor and Executive Council whichever is later, through September 30, 2028.

Funds are available through various individual DAS Plant and Property budgeted class 048 contract maintenance line expenditures for Fiscal Years 2026 and 2027 and are anticipated to be available in 2028, upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds in the future operating budget, with the authority to adjust encumbrances between fiscal years within the price limitation through the Budget Office, if needed and justified.

EXPLANATION

In accordance with RSA 21-I:12, II B, the Department of Administrative Services, Division of Plant and Property Management is responsible to "provide for the general maintenance of state-owned buildings and grounds, except as otherwise provided by law." The Division of Plant and Property maintains 95 state owned buildings located throughout the state. This contract for excavation services is essential to complete timely repairs to our underground utilities including electric, gas, oil, steam, petroleum, communications, water, sewer, storm water and irrigation lines for DAS state-owned buildings.

DAS, through the Bureau of Purchase and Property, issued a request for bid (RFB) DAS 2026-01 for Excavator Services on August 7, 2025, with responses due August 27, 2025. The RFB reached 66 vendors through the NIGP registry with an additional 20 directly sourced. There were four compliant bids received for this multi-award contract. Raymond Landscaping LLC submitted competitive pricing for excavator services in the nine counties for which we requested services. Attached is a copy of the bid results.

It is the Departments intent to enter into one contract with the vendor with the lowest total hourly rates in each of the following counties where there is between 1 and 5 facilities: Belknap, Carroll,

Cheshire, Coos, Grafton, Hillsborough, Rockingham and Strafford. In Merrimack County, where there are 48 state-owned facilities and a higher demand for these services, the Department intends to enter into a contract with two vendors with the lowest total hourly rates.

To calculate the price limitation for excavation services in Merrimack County DAS reviewed historical usage and projected future needs. This included reviewing three years of past project hours and considering upcoming requirements like small paving projects, sinkhole repair, and the replacement of a basement floor (asphalt removal and concrete replacement). While the exact mix of labor and equipment hours over the three-year contract is an estimate, our historical project hours confirms that nearly all projects require both components. Typically, equipment is necessary for the duration of the labor; for example, 8 hours of labor often means there are 4 hours each of dump truck and backhoe use. Consequently, while individual labor and equipment rates vary, the most competitive bids in Merrimack County achieve their low cost through a lower combined total hourly rate for both components. For all projects needed in Merrimack County the Department will reach out to both vendors, Raymonds Landscaping and RH White Construction, and request quotes. The project will be awarded to the vendor that provides the lowest-cost, qualified quote who has availability to meet the project timeline.

In all other Counties other than Merrimack, a lower number of project hours is estimated because these counties only have between one and five state-owned facilities as compared to Merrimack County where there are 48 state-owned facilities.

DAS has determined that Raymonds Landscaping LLC is in good standing with the Secretary of State's Office, has secured the required levels of insurance, and has provided evidence of authority to execute and be bound by the contract. Documents supporting these assertions are available at the agency, for review upon request. Based on the foregoing, I am respectfully recommending approval of the contract with Raymonds Landscaping LLC.



The State of New Hampshire and the Contractor hereby mutually agree as follows:

GENERAL PROVISIONS

2. SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED. The State of New Hampshire, acting through the agency identified in block 1.1 ("State"), engages contractor identified in block 1.3 ("Contractor") to perform, and the Contractor shall perform, the work or sale of goods, or both, identified and more particularly described in the attached EXHIBIT B which is incorporated herein by reference ("Services").

3. EFFECTIVE DATE/COMPLETION OF SERVICES.

3.1 Notwithstanding any provision of this Agreement to the contrary, and subject to the approval of the Governor and Executive Council of the State of New Hampshire, if applicable, this Agreement, and all obligations of the parties hereunder, shall become effective on the date the Governor and Executive Council approve this Agreement, unless no such approval is required, in which case the Agreement shall become effective on the date the Agreement is signed by the State Agency as shown in block 1.13 ("Effective Date").

3.2 If the Contractor commences the Services prior to the Effective Date, all Services performed by the Contractor prior to the Effective Date shall be performed at the sole risk of the Contractor, and in the event that this Agreement does not become effective, the State shall have no liability to the Contractor, including without limitation, any obligation to pay the Contractor for any costs incurred or Services performed.

3.3 Contractor must complete all Services by the Completion Date specified in block 1.7.

4. CONDITIONAL NATURE OF AGREEMENT.

Notwithstanding any provision of this Agreement to the contrary, all obligations of the State hereunder, including, without limitation, the continuance of payments hereunder, are contingent upon the availability and continued appropriation of funds. In no event shall the State be liable for any payments hereunder in excess of such available appropriated funds. In the event of a reduction or termination of appropriated funds by any state or federal legislative or executive action that reduces, eliminates or otherwise modifies the appropriation or availability of funding for this Agreement and the Scope for Services provided in EXHIBIT B, in whole or in part, the State shall have the right to withhold payment until such funds become available, if ever, and shall have the right to reduce or terminate the Services under this Agreement immediately upon giving the Contractor notice of such reduction or termination. The State shall not be required to transfer funds from any other account or source to the Account identified in block 1.6 in the event funds in that Account are reduced or unavailable.

5. CONTRACT PRICE/PRICE LIMITATION/ PAYMENT.

5.1 The contract price, method of payment, and terms of payment are identified and more particularly described in EXHIBIT C which is incorporated herein by reference.

5.2 Notwithstanding any provision in this Agreement to the contrary, and notwithstanding unexpected circumstances, in no event shall the total of all payments authorized, or actually made hereunder, exceed the Price Limitation set forth in block 1.8. The payment by the State of the contract price shall be the only and the complete reimbursement to the Contractor for all expenses, of

whatever nature incurred by the Contractor in the performance hereof and shall be the only and the complete compensation to the Contractor for the Services.

5.3 The State reserves the right to offset from any amounts otherwise payable to the Contractor under this Agreement those liquidated amounts required or permitted by N.H. RSA 80:7 through RSA 80:7-c or any other provision of law.

5.4 The State's liability under this Agreement shall be limited to monetary damages not to exceed the total fees paid. The Contractor agrees that it has an adequate remedy at law for any breach of this Agreement by the State and hereby waives any right to specific performance or other equitable remedies against the State.

6. COMPLIANCE BY CONTRACTOR WITH LAWS AND REGULATIONS/EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY.

6.1 In connection with the performance of the Services, the Contractor shall comply with all applicable statutes, laws, regulations, and orders of federal, state, county or municipal authorities which impose any obligation or duty upon the Contractor, including, but not limited to, civil rights and equal employment opportunity laws and the Governor's order on Respect and Civility in the Workplace, Executive order 2020-01. In addition, if this Agreement is funded in any part by monies of the United States, the Contractor shall comply with all federal executive orders, rules, regulations and statutes, and with any rules, regulations and guidelines as the State or the United States issue to implement these regulations. The Contractor shall also comply with all applicable intellectual property laws.

6.2 During the term of this Agreement, the Contractor shall not discriminate against employees or applicants for employment because of age, sex, sexual orientation, race, color, marital status, physical or mental disability, religious creed, national origin, gender identity, or gender expression, and will take affirmative action to prevent such discrimination, unless exempt by state or federal law. The Contractor shall ensure any subcontractors comply with these nondiscrimination requirements.

6.3 No payments or transfers of value by Contractor or its representatives in connection with this Agreement have or shall be made which have the purpose or effect of public or commercial bribery, or acceptance of or acquiescence in extortion, kickbacks, or other unlawful or improper means of obtaining business.

6.4 The Contractor agrees to permit the State or United States access to any of the Contractor's books, records and accounts for the purpose of ascertaining compliance with this Agreement and all rules, regulations and orders pertaining to the covenants, terms and conditions of this Agreement.

7. PERSONNEL.

7.1 The Contractor shall at its own expense provide all personnel necessary to perform the Services. The Contractor warrants that all personnel engaged in the Services shall be qualified to perform the Services and shall be properly licensed and otherwise authorized to do so under all applicable laws.

7.2 The Contracting Officer specified in block 1.9, or any successor, shall be the State's point of contact pertaining to this Agreement.

8. EVENT OF DEFAULT/REMEDIES.

8.1 Any one or more of the following acts or omissions of the Contractor shall constitute an event of default hereunder ("Event of Default"):

- 8.1.1 failure to perform the Services satisfactorily or on schedule;
- 8.1.2 failure to submit any report required hereunder; and/or
- 8.1.3 failure to perform any other covenant, term or condition of this Agreement.

8.2 Upon the occurrence of any Event of Default, the State may take any one, or more, or all, of the following actions:

8.2.1 give the Contractor a written notice specifying the Event of Default and requiring it to be remedied within, in the absence of a greater or lesser specification of time, thirty (30) calendar days from the date of the notice; and if the Event of Default is not timely cured, terminate this Agreement, effective two (2) calendar days after giving the Contractor notice of termination;

8.2.2 give the Contractor a written notice specifying the Event of Default and suspending all payments to be made under this Agreement and ordering that the portion of the contract price which would otherwise accrue to the Contractor during the period from the date of such notice until such time as the State determines that the Contractor has cured the Event of Default shall never be paid to the Contractor;

8.2.3 give the Contractor a written notice specifying the Event of Default and set off against any other obligations the State may owe to the Contractor any damages the State suffers by reason of any Event of Default; and/or

8.2.4 give the Contractor a written notice specifying the Event of Default, treat the Agreement as breached, terminate the Agreement and pursue any of its remedies at law or in equity, or both.

9. TERMINATION.

9.1 Notwithstanding paragraph 8, the State may, at its sole discretion, terminate the Agreement for any reason, in whole or in part, by thirty (30) calendar days written notice to the Contractor that the State is exercising its option to terminate the Agreement.

9.2 In the event of an early termination of this Agreement for any reason other than the completion of the Services, the Contractor shall, at the State's discretion, deliver to the Contracting Officer, not later than fifteen (15) calendar days after the date of termination, a report ("Termination Report") describing in detail all Services performed, and the contract price earned, to and including the date of termination. In addition, at the State's discretion, the Contractor shall, within fifteen (15) calendar days of notice of early termination, develop and submit to the State a transition plan for Services under the Agreement.

10. PROPERTY OWNERSHIP/DISCLOSURE.

10.1 As used in this Agreement, the word "Property" shall mean all data, information and things developed or obtained during the performance of, or acquired or developed by reason of, this Agreement, including, but not limited to, all studies, reports, files, formulae, surveys, maps, charts, sound recordings, video recordings, pictorial reproductions, drawings, analyses, graphic representations, computer programs, computer printouts, notes, letters, memoranda, papers, and documents, all whether finished or unfinished.

10.2 All data and any Property which has been received from the State, or purchased with funds provided for that purpose under this Agreement, shall be the property of the State, and shall be returned to the State upon demand or upon termination of this Agreement for any reason.

10.3 Disclosure of data, information and other records shall be governed by N.H. RSA chapter 91-A and/or other applicable law. Disclosure requires prior written approval of the State.

11. CONTRACTOR'S RELATION TO THE STATE. In the performance of this Agreement the Contractor is in all respects an independent contractor, and is neither an agent nor an employee of the State. Neither the Contractor nor any of its officers, employees, agents or members shall have authority to bind the State or receive any benefits, workers' compensation or other emoluments provided by the State to its employees.

12. ASSIGNMENT/DELEGATION/SUBCONTRACTS.

12.1 Contractor shall provide the State written notice at least fifteen (15) calendar days before any proposed assignment, delegation, or other transfer of any interest in this Agreement. No such assignment, delegation, or other transfer shall be effective without the written consent of the State.

12.2 For purposes of paragraph 12, a Change of Control shall constitute assignment. "Change of Control" means (a) merger, consolidation, or a transaction or series of related transactions in which a third party, together with its affiliates, becomes the direct or indirect owner of fifty percent (50%) or more of the voting shares or similar equity interests, or combined voting power of the Contractor, or (b) the sale of all or substantially all of the assets of the Contractor.

12.3 None of the Services shall be subcontracted by the Contractor without prior written notice and consent of the State.

12.4 The State is entitled to copies of all subcontracts and assignment agreements and shall not be bound by any provisions contained in a subcontract or an assignment agreement to which it is not a party.

13. INDEMNIFICATION. The Contractor shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the State, its officers, and employees from and against all actions, claims, damages, demands, judgments, fines, liabilities, losses, and other expenses, including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees, arising out of or relating to this Agreement directly or indirectly arising from death, personal injury, property damage, intellectual property infringement, or other claims asserted against the State, its officers, or employees caused by the acts or omissions of negligence, reckless or willful misconduct, or fraud by the Contractor, its employees, agents, or subcontractors. The State shall not be liable for any costs incurred by the Contractor arising under this paragraph 13. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing herein contained shall be deemed to constitute a waiver of the State's sovereign immunity, which immunity is hereby reserved to the State. This covenant in paragraph 13 shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

14. INSURANCE.

14.1 The Contractor shall, at its sole expense, obtain and continuously maintain in force, and shall require any subcontractor or assignee to obtain and maintain in force, the following insurance:

14.1.1 commercial general liability insurance against all claims of bodily injury, death or property damage, in amounts of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate or excess; and

14.1.2 special cause of loss coverage form covering all Property subject to subparagraph 10.2 herein, in an amount not less than 80% of the whole replacement value of the Property.

14.2 The policies described in subparagraph 14.1 herein shall be on policy forms and endorsements approved for use in the State of New Hampshire by the N.H. Department of Insurance, and issued by insurers licensed in the State of New Hampshire.

14.3 The Contractor shall furnish to the Contracting Officer identified in block 1.9, or any successor, a certificate(s) of insurance for all insurance required under this Agreement. At the request of the Contracting Officer, or any successor, the Contractor shall provide certificate(s) of insurance for all renewal(s) of insurance required under this Agreement. The certificate(s) of insurance and any renewals thereof shall be attached and are incorporated herein by reference.

15. WORKERS' COMPENSATION.

15.1 By signing this agreement, the Contractor agrees, certifies and warrants that the Contractor is in compliance with or exempt from, the requirements of N.H. RSA chapter 281-A ("*Workers' Compensation*").

15.2 To the extent the Contractor is subject to the requirements of N.H. RSA chapter 281-A, Contractor shall maintain, and require any subcontractor or assignee to secure and maintain, payment of Workers' Compensation in connection with activities which the person proposes to undertake pursuant to this Agreement. The Contractor shall furnish the Contracting Officer identified in block 1.9, or any successor, proof of Workers' Compensation in the manner described in N.H. RSA chapter 281-A and any applicable renewal(s) thereof, which shall be attached and are incorporated herein by reference. The State shall not be responsible for payment of any Workers' Compensation premiums or for any other claim or benefit for Contractor, or any subcontractor or employee of Contractor, which might arise under applicable State of New Hampshire Workers' Compensation laws in connection with the performance of the Services under this Agreement.

16. WAIVER OF BREACH. A State's failure to enforce its rights with respect to any single or continuing breach of this Agreement shall not act as a waiver of the right of the State to later enforce any such rights or to enforce any other or any subsequent breach.

17. NOTICE. Any notice by a party hereto to the other party shall be deemed to have been duly delivered or given at the time of mailing by certified mail, postage prepaid, in a United States Post Office addressed to the parties at the addresses given in blocks 1.2 and 1.4, herein.

18. AMENDMENT. This Agreement may be amended, waived or discharged only by an instrument in writing signed by the parties hereto and only after approval of such amendment, waiver or discharge by the Governor and Executive Council of the State of New Hampshire unless no such approval is required under the circumstances pursuant to State law, rule or policy.

19. CHOICE OF LAW AND FORUM.

19.1 This Agreement shall be governed, interpreted and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Hampshire except where the Federal supremacy clause requires otherwise. The wording used in this Agreement is the wording chosen by the parties to express their mutual intent, and no rule of construction shall be applied against or in favor of any party.

19.2 Any actions arising out of this Agreement, including the breach or alleged breach thereof, may not be submitted to binding arbitration, but must, instead, be brought and maintained in the Merrimack County Superior Court of New Hampshire which shall have exclusive jurisdiction thereof.

20. CONFLICTING TERMS. In the event of a conflict between the terms of this P-37 form (as modified in EXHIBIT A) and any other portion of this Agreement including any attachments thereto, the terms of the P-37 (as modified in EXHIBIT A) shall control.

21. THIRD PARTIES. This Agreement is being entered into for the sole benefit of the parties hereto, and nothing herein, express or implied, is intended to or will confer any legal or equitable right, benefit, or remedy of any nature upon any other person.

22. HEADINGS. The headings throughout the Agreement are for reference purposes only, and the words contained therein shall in no way be held to explain, modify, amplify or aid in the interpretation, construction or meaning of the provisions of this Agreement.

23. SPECIAL PROVISIONS. Additional or modifying provisions set forth in the attached EXHIBIT A are incorporated herein by reference.

24. FURTHER ASSURANCES. The Contractor, along with its agents and affiliates, shall, at its own cost and expense, execute any additional documents and take such further actions as may be reasonably required to carry out the provisions of this Agreement and give effect to the transactions contemplated hereby.

25. SEVERABILITY. In the event any of the provisions of this Agreement are held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be contrary to any state or federal law, the remaining provisions of this Agreement will remain in full force and effect.

26. ENTIRE AGREEMENT. This Agreement, which may be executed in a number of counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, constitutes the entire agreement and understanding between the parties, and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings with respect to the subject matter hereof.

1. INTRODUCTION:

1.1. Raymond's Landscaping LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") hereby agrees to provide the State of New Hampshire (hereinafter referred to as the "State"), Department of Administrative Services, with Excavation Services in all Counties in accordance with the proposal submission in response to State Request for Bid # DAS 2026-01 and as described herein.

2. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:

- 2.1. This Contract consists of the following documents ("Contract Documents"):
- State of New Hampshire Terms and Conditions, General Provisions Form P-37
 - EXHIBIT A Special Provisions
 - EXHIBIT B Scope of Services
 - EXHIBIT C Method of Payment
- 2.2. In the event of any conflict among the terms or provisions of the documents listed above, the following order of priority shall indicate which documents control: (1), Form Number P-37 as modified by EXHIBIT A "Special Provisions, (2) EXHIBIT B "Scope of Services," (3) EXHIBIT C "Method of Payment".

3. TERM OF CONTRACT:

- 3.1. The term of the contract shall commence on October 1, 2025, or upon approval of the Governor and Executive Council, whichever is later, through September 30, 2028.
- 3.2. The contract may be extended for up to an additional two (2) years thereafter under the same terms, conditions, and pricing structure upon the mutual agreement between the Contractor and the State with the approval of the Governor and Executive Council.

4. SCOPE OF WORK:

4.1. The Contractor shall provide Excavation Services to facilitate the timely repair of underground facilities including but not limited to electric, gas, oil, steam, petroleum, communications, water, sewer, storm water and irrigation lines for its buildings located in all NH counties as listed below under Site Location. The State reserves the right to add or delete locations within the geographical regions.

- 4.2. The Contractor shall provide all supervision, labor, materials, transportation, tools, equipment, construction equipment and machinery necessary to satisfactorily complete the Excavation Services as identified below.
- 4.3. The Excavation services shall include the following:
 - 4.3.1. Excavation, complete debris removal and offsite disposal; fill and paving and or concrete work in order to return the disturbed work areas in proper and safe condition;
 - 4.3.2. Repair of water, sewer and storm water systems including piping, manholes, frames, hand holes, catch basins, grates, covers and outfalls and all culverts;
 - 4.3.3. Testing of completed piping work;
 - 4.3.4. Other general excavation related services requested by the State;
 - 4.3.5. Pavement services either in house or through a sub-contractor as requested by the State; and
 - 4.3.6. Catch basin cleaning services either in house or through a sub-contractor as requested by the State.
- 4.4. Individual projects shall not exceed \$25,000 including all costs associated with any individual project, including supervision, labor, material, equipment, construction equipment, machinery and supplies etc., unless a waiver is granted by the Director of Plant and Property Management.
- 4.5. The Contractor shall submit not to exceed quotes for individual projects at rates listed in Exhibit C in this contract.
- 4.6. For emergency projects requiring immediate attention, the Contractor shall work on a Time and Materials basis subject to review and approval by the State Project Manager.
- 4.7. All work performed under this contract shall be scheduled by the State Project Manager from the Department of Administrative Services.
- 4.8. Unless the Contractor is directed differently by the State Project Manager, all materials, parts, and work shall be in compliance with DOT specifications as detailed in Attachment 1: Appendix A of the Bid # DAS 2026-01.
- 4.9. All materials and supplies shall be invoiced at a markup not to exceed 10% over contractor's cost.
- 4.10. Subcontractors work may be invoiced at a markup not to exceed 10% over contractor's cost.
- 4.11. Invoices must be submitted to the State by the Contractor at the rates quoted in the contract. If additional equipment is required beyond the excavation tools listed in the contract, they must be procured and billed to the project subject to prior approval of the State Project Manager. All materials shall be invoiced not exceed 10% over the Contractor's cost.
- 4.12. The Contractor's typical working hours under any resulting contract will range from 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM Monday through Friday, but occasions may arise which would require work to be performed before or after these hours, on weekends, or holidays. The typical working hours may vary by the type of facility or the operational needs of the State where work is being performed and will be established at the beginning of each project.
- 4.13. The Contractor shall make service available twenty-four hours per day, seven days per week for emergency excavation services. The Contractor shall provide one (1) dispatch telephone number or other electronic means of communicating that shall be available 24/7 for emergencies.

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- 4.14. The Contractor shall respond by phone or other electronic device to all emergency excavation service calls within fifteen (15) minutes of reported occurrence. The Contractor shall physically respond to the site within four hours of receipt of notification from the State.
- 4.15. The Contractor shall respond by phone or other electronic device to all non-emergency excavation service calls within eight (8) hours after report of occurrence.
- 4.16. The Contractor shall employ sufficient number of trained personnel so that all request for excavation service calls are answered within the required time limitations.
- 4.17. The Contractor shall notify the State Project Manager of any maintenance related issues that are discovered while performing the work.
- 4.18. The Contractor shall secure any permits, schedule inspections and be on site during inspections. The Contractor shall ensure that inspections are made by the appropriate State and or local authority having jurisdiction. The Contractor will invoice the State for the cost of the permit or inspection fees, at no markup, as part of the Excavation Services. The permit or inspection cost will be itemized on the detailed invoice at the completion of the work.
- 4.19. The Contractor shall give all notices and comply with all laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and lawful orders of any public authority bearing on the performance of the work.
- 4.20. The Contractor shall initiate, maintain and supervise all safety precautions and programs in connection with the work.
- 4.21. The Contractor shall take all reasonable precautions for the safety of, and shall provide all reasonable protection to prevent damage, injury or loss to:
 - 4.21.1. All employees of the work and all other people who may be affected thereby;
 - 4.21.2. all the work and all materials and equipment to be incorporated therein, whether in storage on or off-site, under the care; custody or control of the Contractor or any of their subcontractor(s); and
 - 4.21.3. other property at the site or adjacent thereto, including trees, shrubs, lawns, walks, pavement, roadway structures and utilities not designated for removal, relocation or replacement in the course of construction.
- 4.22. The Contractor shall give all notices and comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, rules, regulations and lawful orders of any public authority bearing on the safety of persons or property or their protection from damage, injury or loss.
- 4.23. The Contractor shall erect and maintain; as required by existing conditions and progress of the work, all reasonable safeguards for safety and protection, including posting danger signs and other warnings against hazards, promulgating safety regulations and notifying owners and users of adjacent utilities.
- 4.24. The Contractor shall provide and maintain as required any traffic control measures to ensure safety to employees and the public.
- 4.25. The Contractor shall also be aware of laws and regulations relating to hazardous materials that may be encountered during construction operations. The health and safety of employees, the general public, and the potential of damage to the overall environment is possible if hazardous materials are not recognized, reported, and the appropriate action taken to dispose of, remove from the site, or otherwise contain the possible contaminants.
- 4.26. If any abnormal condition is encountered or exposed that indicates the presence of a hazardous material or toxic waste, construction operations shall be immediately suspended in the project area and the State Project Manager notified. No further work shall be conducted in the area of the contaminated material until the site has been investigated and the State has given approval to continue the work in the area. The Contractor shall fully cooperate with the State and perform any remedial work as directed. Work shall continue in other areas of the Project unless otherwise directed.
- 4.27. The Contractor shall provide adequate supervision of their employees to ensure complete and satisfactory performance of all work in accordance with the terms of the contract.

- 4.28. The Contractor shall pre-mark areas of intended excavation in accordance with NH PUC 806 and notify NH Dig Safe. The Contractor shall comply with all NH Public Utilities 800, Underground Utility Damage Prevention Program Rules.
- 4.29. The Contractor shall grade site to drain and maintain excavations free of water. The Contractor shall provide, operate and maintain the necessary pumping equipment.
- 4.30. The Contractor shall protect the project site from puddling and running water. They shall provide water barriers as required to protect the project site from soil erosion.
- 4.31. The Contractor shall execute the work by methods that minimize raising dust from construction operations. The Contractor shall provide positive means to prevent air borne dust from dispersing into the atmosphere.
- 4.32. The Contractor shall execute the work with methods to control surface drainage from cuts and fills and from borrow and waste disposal areas. The Contractor shall prevent erosion and sedimentation.
- 4.33. The Contractor shall minimize surface area of bare soil exposed at one time.
- 4.34. The Contractor shall provide temporary measures including berms, dikes, and drains, and other devices to prevent water flow.
- 4.35. The Contractor shall construct fill and waste areas by selective placement to avoid erosive surface silts or clays.
- 4.36. The Contractor shall periodically inspect earthwork to detect evidence of erosion and sedimentation and promptly apply corrective measures as required.
- 4.37. The Contractor shall provide methods, means, and facilities to minimize noise from demolition and noise produced by construction operations.
- 4.38. The Contractor shall provide methods, means, and facilities to prevent contamination of soil, water, and atmosphere from discharge of noxious, toxic substances, and pollutants produced by construction operations.
- 4.39. The Contractor shall comply with pollution and environmental control requirements of authorities having jurisdiction.
- 4.40. The Contractor equipment shall be the size and type appropriate for completing the various types of excavation work. The Contractor shall ensure that any equipment considered by the State Project Manager to be improper or inadequate for the purpose is removed from the site and replaced with satisfactory equipment.
- 4.41. The Contractor shall ensure that all materials shall be of the best quality, all work is completed in a professional manner, and all aspects of the project are delivered in good working order, complete and perfect in every respect. All materials and equipment shall be new unless otherwise specified and all Excavation Services shall be good quality free from faults and defects.
- 4.42. The Contractor shall ensure that all supplies, equipment and machines shall be kept free of traffic lanes or other areas that may be hazardous. The Contractor shall further ensure that all dirt and debris resulting from the work under any resulting contract, shall be disposed of at the end of each day or at the completion of work.
- 4.43. The Contractor shall, at no additional cost to the State, repair furnishings, equipment, facilities or other property of the State damaged by the Contractor, its officers, employees, agents, contractors, sub-contractors and invitees.
- 4.44. The Contractor shall keep the premises free from accumulation of waste materials or rubbish. At the completion of the project they shall remove all their waste materials and rubbish from and about the project as well as all their tools, construction equipment, machinery any surplus materials and shall leave the premises in a clean and satisfactory condition at all times.
- 4.45. The Contractor shall supervise and direct the work, using their best skill and attention. The Contractor shall be solely responsible for all construction means, methods, techniques, sequences and procedures and for coordinating all portion of the work. All aspects of the project shall be subject to the inspection and

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approval of the State. The Contractor guarantees to repair, replace, re-execute or otherwise correct any defect in workmanship, materials, of the like that fails to conform to the requirements of the State, or that appear during the progress of the work or within one year of final acceptance by the State.

- 4.46. The Contractor shall perform all the work and furnish all the materials, tools, equipment and safety devices necessary to perform in the manner and within the time hereinafter specified. The Contractor shall complete the entire work to the satisfaction of the State and in accordance with the specifications herein mentioned, at the price herein agreed upon and fixed therefore. All the work furnished under this contract, shall be done and furnished strictly pursuant to, and in conformity with the specifications described herein, and the directions of the State representatives as given from time to time during the progress of the work, under the terms of the contract.
- 4.47. The Contractor shall take all responsibility for the work under the contract; for the protection of the work; and for preventing injuries to persons and damage to property and utilities on or about the work. They shall in no way be relieved of their responsibility by any right of the State to give permission or issue orders relating to any part of the work; or by any such permission given on orders issued or by failure of the State to give such permission or issue such orders. The Contractor shall bear all losses resulting to him or to the State on account of the amount or character of the work, or because of the nature of the area in or on which the work is done is differed from what was estimated or expected, or account of the weather, elements or other causes.
- 4.48. The Contractor agrees that any damage or injury to buildings, materials, and equipment or to other property by the Contractor during the performance of this service shall be repaired at their own expense.
- 4.49. The Contractor shall be responsible to the State for the acts and omissions of their employees, subcontractors and their agents and employees and other persons performing any of the work under a contract.
- 4.50. The Contractor shall acquaint themselves with the limits of the property or right-of-way of the State and shall not trespass on other property. The Contractor shall adequately protect the project, adjacent property and the public and shall be responsible for any damage or injury due to the Contractor act or neglect and shall save the State harmless in respect thereto.
- 4.51. All work shall be done in such a manner as not to interfere with the State's operating functions. The Contractor and their employees shall familiarize themselves and comply with all rules and regulations applicable to each project.
- 4.52. The Contractor shall take photographs of the project site and construction throughout the progress of the Work. The pictures shall be provided to the State with the related invoice.
- 4.53. The work staff shall consist of qualified persons completely familiar with the products and equipment they shall use. The Contracting State Officer may require the Contractor to dismiss from the work such employees as deems incompetent, careless, insubordinate, or otherwise objectionable, or whose continued employment on the work is deemed to be contrary to the public interest or inconsistent with the best interest of security and the State.
- 4.54. The Contractor or their personnel shall not represent themselves as employees or agents of the State.
- 4.55. While on State property, employees shall be subject to the control of the State, but under no circumstances shall such persons be deemed to be employees of the State.
- 4.56. All personnel shall observe all regulations or special restrictions in effect at the State.

EXHIBIT C - METHOD OF PAYMENT

5. CONTRACT PRICE:

5.1. The Contractor hereby agrees to provide Excavation Services at the rates posted below for a not to exceed total of \$885,000 (herein referred to as the contract price) in return for the services described in Exhibit B.

6. SCHEDULED EXCAVATION SERVICES

6.1. The Contractor shall submit not to exceed quotes for individual projects at rates established in this Contract. Individual projects are not to exceed \$25,000 including all costs associated with any individual project, including supervision, labor, material, equipment, construction equipment, machinery and supplies etc.

7. EMERGENCY EXCAVATION SERVICES

7.1. For emergency projects requiring immediate attention, the Contractor shall work on a Time and Materials basis at the rates stated below subject to review and approval of the State Project Manager.

8. HOURLY LABOR AND EQUIPMENT RATES

8.1. The hourly labor rates are inclusive of all expenses including all overhead, profit, superintendence, insurances, training, travel and taxes. The equipment hourly rates are also fully inclusive as described above and include the hourly rate of the respective equipment operators. The hourly rate shall start when the Contractor's personnel arrive at the work site and when the personnel leave the work site.

8.2. The hourly labor and equipment rates shall include all fees including any travel time and or mileage expenses. Special charges, surcharges, processing charges, or fuel charges of any kind (by whatever name) may not be added on at any time.

9. MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES

9.1. All materials and supplies shall be invoiced at a markup not to exceed 10% over Contractor's cost.

10. SUBCONTRACTOR RATES

10.1. Subcontractor's work shall be invoiced at a markup not to exceed 10% over contractor's cost.

11. For Excavating Services issued on a fixed price basis the following information is required on all invoices:

11.1. Description of the project;

11.2. Time frame indicated of when work was performed;

11.3. Number of hours per person worked

11.4. Copy of original quote submitted to State Project Manager;

11.5. Provide supporting documentation of material costs and or subcontractor costs, not to exceed 10% mark up.

12. For Emergency Excavating Services awarded on a Time and Material basis, the following additional information must be included on all invoices:

12.1. Description of the Work

12.2. Number of hours per person worked

12.3. Copies of original receipts for all materials purchased or costs incurred as a result of the scope of work.

13. PERMIT OR INSPECTION FEES

13.1. The Contractor shall invoice the State for the cost of any permit or inspection fees, at no markup, as part of the Excavation Services. The permit or inspection cost will be itemized on the detailed invoice at the completion of the work.

14. INVOICE:

14.1. Contractor shall be paid within 30 days after receipt of properly documented invoice and acceptance of the work to the State's satisfaction.

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


