Your Excellency and Members of the Council:

REQUESTED ACTION

That approval be and hereby is given to the Attorney General to appoint Nicholas J. Apostolopoulos, to Position #9U735 (Appropriation #02-20-20-202010-1037-014-500134), as an Assistant Deputy Medical Examiner, at a salary level of \$66,192 (Labor Grade BB, Step 1), effective upon Governor and Executive Council approval, or January 9, 2026, whichever is later. 100% Agency Income.

EXPLANATION

Chapter 79 Laws of 2023 (HB2) established within the Department of Justice the unclassified position entitled Assistant Deputy Medical Examiner to be appointed by the Attorney General pursuant to RSA 21-M:3, XIV, and to serve at the pleasure of the Chief Medical Examiner pursuant to RSA 611-B:5.

Mr. Apostolopoulos, a Manchester resident, is certified as a Water Restoration Technician, Trauma Crime Scene Technician, and CPR/Basic Life Support instructor, and is a licensed Emergency Medical Technician. From 2017 to 2019, he was a Clinical Assistant at Boston Children's Hospital providing direct patient care on a 23-bed medical ICU. From 2019 to 2024, he worked as an EMT for Brewster Ambulance Service, providing Basic Life Support care throughout Massachusetts and New Hampshire on a dual certified ambulance. In January 2022, he began working at UMass Memorial Healthcare as an EMT, and at Life Safety Institute as an Adjunct Instructor/Director of CPR and First Aid where he instructed and assisted in the didactic and lab instruction of EMT students. From 2024 to 2025, he worked at Insurcomm/1-800-BOARDUP, where he was an Assistant Director of Emergency Services acting as a project manager for EMS and biohazardous jobs physically securing homes after a loss. Since 2024, he has been an EMT for Nottingham Fire-Rescue, serving as a per diem EMT providing emergency basic life support care and assisting in advanced life support interventions. He is currently pursuing a Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration with a Concentration in
